8. Refund Policy and Procedures

Jeryk EC is committed to maintaining a transparent and fair refund process for all learners. Refunds are only considered when students submit a valid written request supported by the appropriate documentation. All refund applications will be reviewed case-by-case, and only approved refunds will be processed.

Where students choose to use loans or instalment schemes with third-party providers, refunds will be subjected to the terms and policies of the external financing institution. Approval of the refund request is fully dependent on the approval of the third-party financing provider.

To apply for a refund, students must submit the Refund Form to the Centre's administration. Once received, Jeryk EC will assess the request and inform the student of the outcome. Processing begins only upon receipt of all required documents, and approved refunds will be issued according to the Centre's payment schedule.

9. Course Transfer, Deferment and Withdrawal Policy

9.1 Overall Policy

Jeryk EC allows students to transfer courses, withdraw, or request deferment, provided the request is made formally and with valid reasons. All requests must be submitted through the appropriate forms. Approval is not automatic and will depend on the student's academic standing, course availability, outstanding payments, and supporting documentation. Students under third-party financing must follow the financing provider's terms before any transfer, withdrawal, or deferment can be approved.

9.2 Course Transfer

A course transfer refers to a student switching from one programme to another within the Centre. Students must complete the Course Transfer Form and provide their reasons and supporting documents. The Academic Department will review the student's suitability for the new course, while Finance will verify fee implications. Only upon final approval will the transfer be processed.

9.3 Course Withdrawal

Withdrawal is defined as the student discontinuing their studies at the Centre. Students must submit the Withdrawal Form along with identification and any required supporting documents. All outstanding fees must be settled before a withdrawal is approved. The official withdrawal date will be the date the Centre receives the completed form.

9.4 Course Deferment

Students may request to defer their course due to personal, medical, or other valid reasons. A deferment request must be submitted with documentation such as medical certificates or employer letters. Approval will be granted for a specified period only. If the student does not return by the agreed date, it may be treated as a withdrawal. Upon resuming, students may be required to repeat modules or assessments depending on syllabus changes.



10. Student Code of Conduct - Academic Honesty Policy

All students of Jeryk EC are expected to uphold integrity, professionalism, and ethical behaviour. Academic honesty is the foundation of our learning environment, and students must ensure that all submitted work is original and properly referenced. Plagiarism, cheating, falsification of documents, or any form of academic misconduct is strictly prohibited.

Students are responsible for understanding what constitutes plagiarism and must seek clarification when unsure. Any student found to have breached academic honesty standards may face disciplinary action, including failing the assignment, suspension, or expulsion. 11. Student Disciplinary Policy
