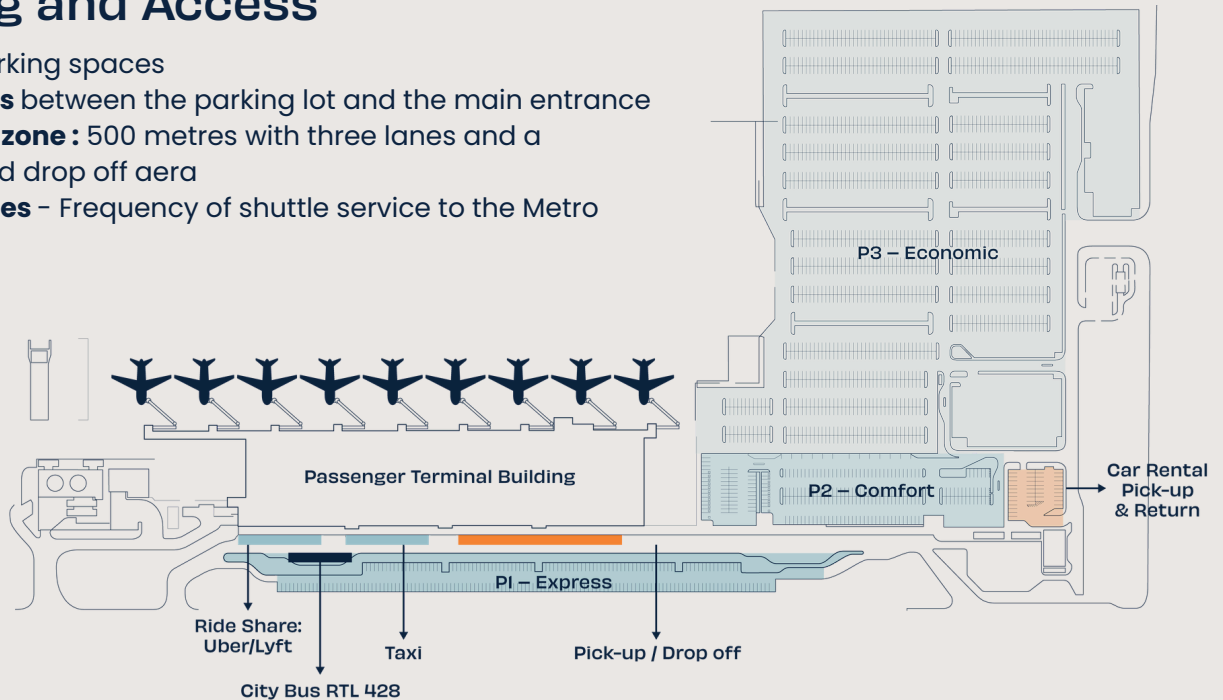

Parking and Access

- **2,600** parking spaces
- **25 metres** between the parking lot and the main entrance
- **Drop-off zone** : 500 metres with three lanes and a dedicated drop off area
- **35 minutes** - Frequency of shuttle service to the Metro

Current number of daily flights: approx. 175



Estimated number of new commercial flights per day upon opening: 30 – 40



Annual capacity: 4 million passengers

Human Resources

- Number of employees at opening: 200
- Number of direct employees: 500

Environment and Energy Efficiency

- Fully electric building
- 95% of the vehicles are electric
- **Recovery:** Glycol (de-icing fluid) is recovered and recycled
- **Environmental certification:** MET – Montreal Metropolitan Airport holds the only carbon certification for airports: Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA)
