\$500k Recovery of FTL Theft

Location: Mississauga, Canada

This past weekend, Overhaul's LE Connect team was notified of a potential threat to an FTL shipment containing about \$500,000 worth of connectivity hardware. The shipment originated in Southern California, and was destined for Markham, Canada.

The shipment travelled smoothly until crossing into Canada, where the drivers made a stop in Mississauga, Ontario, roughly 20 miles before arriving at the final delivery. While the shipment was stopped, sensors detected a possible intrusion in the trailer. Overhaul's LE Connect team was quickly notified, and responded by coordinating with local police. The team provided live tracking data, as well as comprehensive shipment details, including photographs of the tractor and trailer, enabling a swift response.



Police were able to quickly locate the shipment, which had been left parked on the side of the road. Inspection revealed that the trailer's security seal had been cut, indicating attempted unauthorized access. However, the timely intervention meant all the cargo was accounted for, and remained undisturbed. Overhaul would like to thank the Peel Regional Police for their rapid and effective response.



Overhaul's Recommendation:

Overhaul recommends reviewing security protocols and establishing strong communication channels to effectively respond to future security threats. It is important to maintain a clear chain of escalation and thoroughly document all details for every driver, tractor, and trailer arriving to pick up cargo. This documentation should include comprehensive photographs capturing all identifying markings on both the tractor and trailer, as well as photos of the driver and their CDL. Additionally, ensure that all recorded information is verified against the details provided prior to the driver's arrival.
