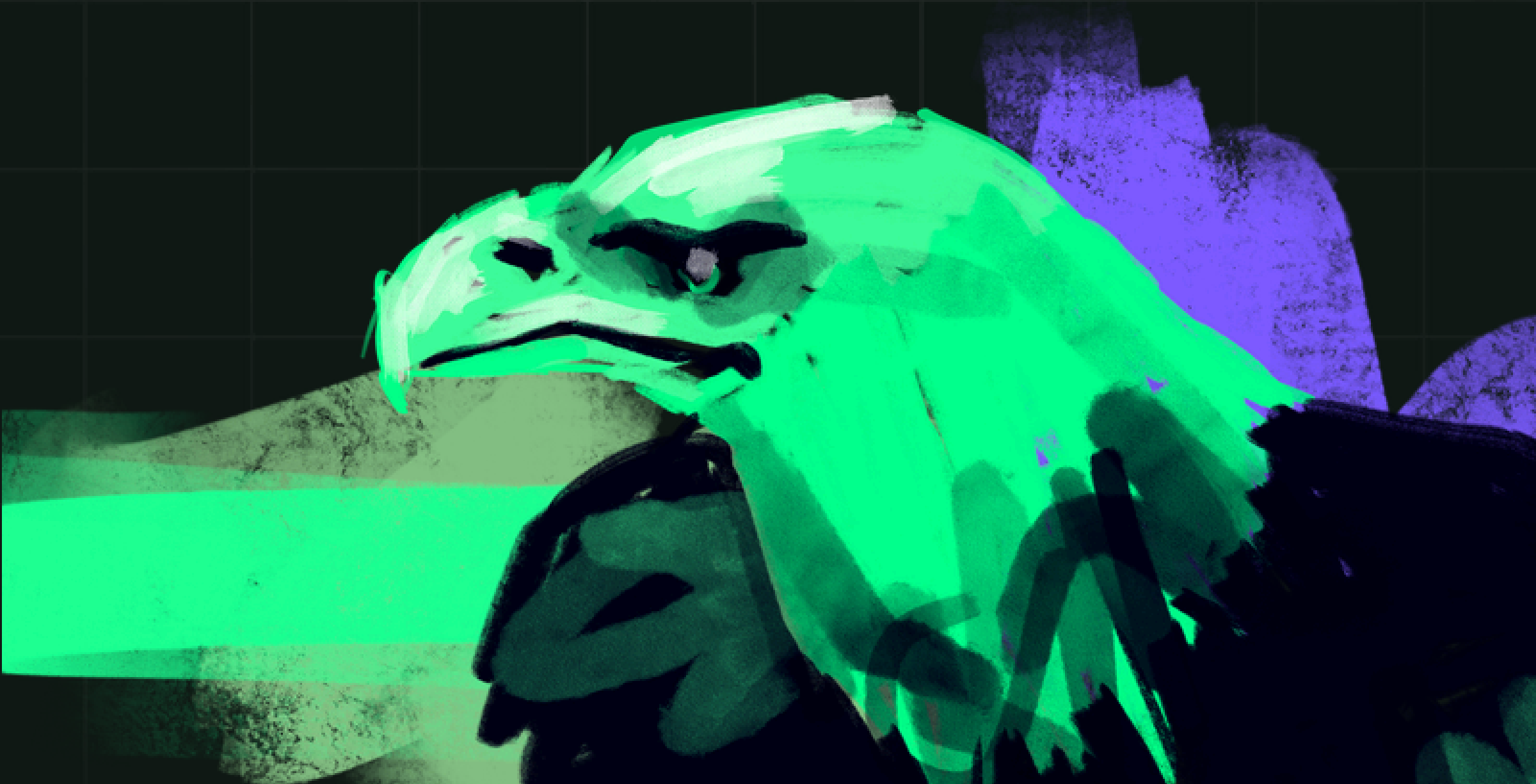

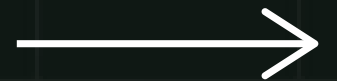
On Monday, Overhaul facilitated the recovery of five stolen shipments in operations spanning Mexico and the United States, resulting in the arrest of seven suspects.

Overhaul's Global Security Operations Centers (GSOC) in Mexico and the US, as well as the LE Connect team collaborated to respond to multiple theft incidents throughout the day.



Among the recovered shipments were shipments of liquor destined for Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, and a load of portable electronics in Southern California.

The recovery of the electronics also led authorities to products from additional shipments at the same location. Overhaul's rapid response and coordination were instrumental in these recoveries.

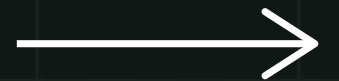


Liquor Shipment Hijacking in Jalisco, Mexico

Overhaul was alerted to a theft involving a convoy transporting liquor destined for Nuevo Laredo, Mexico. The convoy consisted of four vehicles; during transit in Jalisco, three vehicles were stopped and hijacked by organized criminals. The fourth vehicle successfully evaded the hijackers and immediately contacted Overhaul's response team.

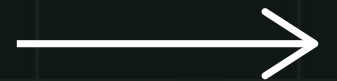


Overhaul promptly activated its recovery protocols, coordinating with private security providers and local law enforcement agencies to track the stolen shipments. Through real-time monitoring and collaborative efforts, all three hijacked shipments were located and recovered fully intact. The case remains under investigation, and currently the perpetrators remain at large. Overhaul continues to advise heightened security measures in Mexico, where cargo hijackings are a persistent risk.



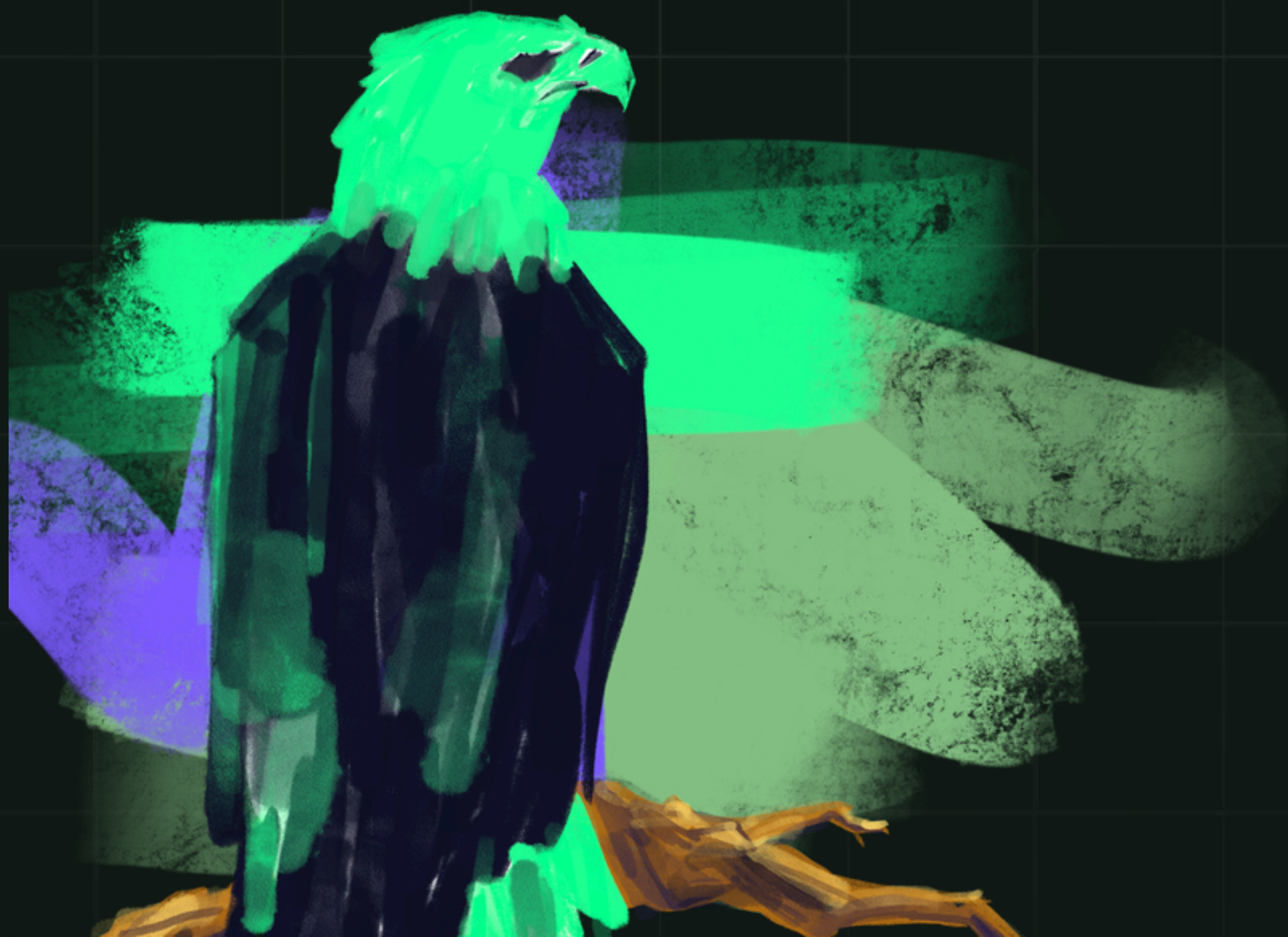
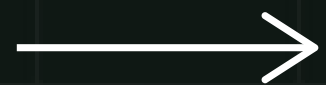
Electronics Theft and Recovery in Southern California, USA

On the same day, Overhaul enabled the recovery of a high-value shipment of portable electronics in Southern California. Overhaul's team leveraged advanced tracking technology to trace the stolen cargo to Southern California. Working closely with law enforcement, authorities obtained a search warrant and searched the premises.



The operation led to the seizure of 100 cases of stolen electronics, \$28,000 in cash, firearms, and additionally product from a separate theft was also found and recovered.

Seven suspects were arrested at the scene and taken into custody. These arrests likely represent a fraction of this theft crew.



Overhaul's Recommendation:

Reviewing yard security protocols and establishing strong communication channels to effectively respond to future security threats.

It is important to maintain a clear chain of escalation and thoroughly document all details for every driver, tractor, and trailer arriving to pick up cargo. This documentation should include comprehensive photographs capturing all identifying markings on both the tractor and trailer, as well as photos of the driver and their CDL.

Additionally, ensure that all recorded information is verified against the details provided prior to the driver's arrival.
