What is Women on Boards?

Women on Boards Program is an endeavour to provide opportunities to women professionals for finding purpose for themselves by taking up Board roles in Social Purpose Organisations (SPOs). This immersive, experiential, three module program would enable women leaders to share their experience with SPOs in a "board role" and lend their expertise to social sector organisations by becoming "board - ready".

The program aims to expand leadership potential to engage with non-profit organisations by equipping women leaders with the necessary perspectives, tools, and engagement strategies, as well as providing networking opportunities with SPOs.

Synopsis

The Women on Boards program provides a platform that enables the transfer of learnings, thoughts and ideas, between the corporate and social impact sectors, while enabling higher diversity on nonprofit boards—diversity both in terms of women's participation and diversity of experience and expertise.



Why Women on Boards?

While there has already been a significant growth of women at senior levels in the corporate sector, there is still a lack of women in advisory/ board roles in social impact organisations. Given the SDGs' emphasis on gender equality, the program focuses on equal participation of women in the boardrooms, where strategic decisions are made and the direction of organisations is set. By becoming members of the Advisory Boards of social purpose organisations, women leaders can contribute to the social impact space while leveraging their networks, leadership skills, and technical knowledge.
