

# Level 1 ACC Credentialing Pathway Programme

## Programme Overview

The Level 1 CCPC programme is built around achieving measurable outcomes that align with ICF Professional Standards, Ethics, and Core Competencies. By the end of the programme, participants are equipped not only with foundational coaching skills but also with coach-practitioner level mastery required to drive meaningful, sustained impact.

The programme is structured into [three key phases](#).

- **Phase 1** provides learners with Core Coaching Education, laying a strong foundation in the ethics of coaching, the coaching mindset and the competencies for effective coaching.
- **Phase 2** has learners engage in [Mentor Coaching](#) and [Coaching Practicum](#), refining their skills through real-world coaching, peer practice, feedback and feedforwarding.
- **Phase 3** involves the [final performance evaluation](#) at the ACC standards, where learners must demonstrate minimum skill requirements of an ACC level proficiency standard to attain eligibility for ACC credentialing.

**Participants who have completed at least 40 hours of coach-specific education and wish to pursue formal ICF Credentialing will bridge the hours to complete the full 60 hours and be supported to prepare for ACC credentialing.**
