

THAI TO FINALIZE DEAL TO BUY 30 NEW AIRCRAFT

Thai Airways (THAI) aims to finalize a deal to buy at least 30 new aircraft by the end of the year and could double its fleet of narrow-body jets over the next decade, according to its chief executive.

The carrier is looking to cash in on a post-pandemic travel boom by bolstering regional routes, but there have been concerns over whether planemakers Airbus and Boeing will be able to ramp up output to meet delivery targets.

These aircraft would be deployed to serve destinations in Southeast Asia, India, southern China and southern Japan; key medium-haul routes that THAI wants to reinforce.

"That's for the short term," THAI CEO Chai Eamsiri said that the aircraft will be used on long-distance intercontinental routes to Australia and Europe that have seen a strong recovery since the pandemic.

THAI's cabin factor - the percentage of seats sold - was at about 84% in the last quarter and the CEO said advance bookings from markets like Europe were looking "promising".

SMALL HOTEL POLICY GETS THA APPROVAL

The Thai Hotels Association (THA) approved the Ministry of Interior's new regulation that will allow smaller accommodations operated before 2016 to be regulated as hotels, as the government would be able to receive more income from tax collection.

However, the association still opposes the plan to exempt larger forms of accommodation from registering under the Hotel Act.

Adding the new registered hotels would boost fair competition for 2-3 star hotels which are on the same tier as the smaller accommodation, particularly in terms of tax payment

On 20 June, the Interior Ministry announced that the ministerial regulations which allowed other types of buildings that did not fit under the definition of "hotel" in accordance with the Hotel Act, but opened before 16 Aug 2016, would be able to register for hotel licences

INTERNATIONAL CRUISE SHIPS HIGHLIGHTED AS MAJOR CONTRIBUTORS TO THAI TOURISM

The Thai Maritime Enforcement Command Center (TMECC) has reported that since the end of 2022, a total of 83 international cruise ships carrying more than 310,000 passengers have generated over 2 billion baht in tourism-related income for Thailand.

Navy Commander Admiral Choengchai Chomchoengpaet, who serves as the deputy chief of TMECC, revealed these figures while highlighting the significant economic impact of cruise tourism on the country.

The recorded statistics encompass the period of October 2022 to the present, during which the TMECC has been responsible for ensuring the safety of tourists aboard cruise ships arriving in the Andaman Seas and the Gulf of Thailand

THAILAND CASHES IN ON RUSSIAN TOURISM BOOM


Direct flights between Russia and Thailand resumed in October last year, and there are now 90 roundtrips each week. In February, they were filled with about 186,000 Russians. One of the busiest routes operated by Russian airline Aeroflot goes to Phuket, a popular beach destination.

It's all in stark contrast to Japan, the United States and a host of European nations, who have all banned direct flights from Russia.

Before the coronavirus pandemic, tourism accounted for 20 percent of Thailand's GDP. The industry is getting back on its feet, and many businesses are happy to see the Russians pour in.

A travel company in Phuket with mainly Russian customers is posting record revenues on the back of the boom.
