- Measures to enter Thailand for non-Thai nationals
 1. Non-Thai nationals who are spouses, parents or children of Thai nationals
 2. Non-Thai nationals who have certificate of residence or have been permitted to take up residency in Thailand
 3. Non-Thai nationals who have a work permit or have been granted permission to work in Thailand, including their spouses or children
 4. Non-Thai nationals who are students of educational establishments in Thailand approved by Thai authorities, including their parents or guardians
 5. Non-Thai nationals in need of medical treatment in Thailand, except for treatment of COVID-19, including their accompanying persons (not exceeding 3 persons)#COVID19 #COVID19Thailand. [See infographic here](#)
- Airports of Thailand (AOT) has disclosed that all passengers must wear a face mask or a face mask with face shield before entering airport buildings. Passengers who wear only a face shield will not be allowed to enter the airport. The measure is one of the prevention measures to reduce the spread of #COVID19. See Infographic here
