



## Hemorrhage Control


Expert management of Antepartum (APH) and Postpartum Hemorrhage (PPH).

Abdominal hysterectomies, myomectomies for uterine fibroids, and complex ovarian masses.




## Vaginal & Pelvic Floor

Laparoscopic-assisted gynaecological procedures for faster patient recovery times.




## Emergency Interventions


Emergency cesarean sections and life-saving cesarean hysterectomies.


## Postpartum Hemorrhage (PPH)


## Pre-Eclampsia / Eclampsia


