

## Morning Duas

1. **اللَّهُمَّ بِكَ أَصْبَحْنَا، وَبِكَ أَمْسَيْنَا، وَبِكَ نَحْيَا، وَبِكَ نَمُوتُ، وَإِلَيْكَ النُّشُورُ**  
The Prophet ﷺ used to say this supplication once every morning and evening, and commanded us to say it. (Bukhari)
2. **حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ عَلَيْهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ وَهُوَ رَبُّ الْعَرْشِ الْعَظِيمِ**  
Whoever recites this 7 times in the morning and evening Allah ta'ala shall make his major important tasks easy. (Muslim)
3. **حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ وَنِعْمَ الْوَكِيلُ**  
When the Sahaba (RA) recited this, Allah ta'ala blessed them with the gifts of both worlds.
4. **أَعُوذُ بِكَلِمَاتِ اللَّهِ التَّامَّاتِ مِنْ عَضْبِهِ، وَعِقَابِهِ، وَشَرِّ عِبَادِهِ، وَمِنْ هَمَزَاتِ الشَّيَاطِينِ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ رَبَّ أَنْ يَحْضُرُونِ**  
Reciting this dua in the morning and evening is a means of protection from evil of humans and jinn.
5. **بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الَّذِي لَا يَضُرُّ مَعَ اسْمِهِ شَيْءٌ فِي الْأَرْضِ وَلَا فِي السَّمَاءِ وَهُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ (3)**  
By reciting 3x morning and evening, Allah ta'ala protects the reciter to such an extent that nothing can cause one harm. (Tirmidhi)
6. **رَضِيْتُ بِاللَّهِ رَبًّا، وَبِالْإِسْلَامِ دِينًا، وَبِمُحَمَّدٍ رَسُولًا (3)**  
Jannah becomes wajib for the individual (Abu Dawud, Nasai') Allah ta'ala will become pleased with the individual. (Tirmidhi)
7. **لِلَّهِمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ وَأَنَا عَلَى عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتَنْطَعْتُ أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ وَأَبُوءُ لَكَ بِذُنُوبِي فَاعْفُرْ لِي فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ**  
If one passes away having recited with true certainty in it, morning & evening, the person will be in Jannah. (Tirmidhi)
8. **اللَّهُمَّ أَجْرِنِي مِنَ النَّارِ**  
Whoever seeks refuge from the Fire three times, the Fire says: 'O Allah, save him/her from the Fire. (Abu Dawud)
9. **اللَّهُمَّ مَا أَصْبَحَ بِي مِنْ نِعْمَةٍ أَوْ بِأَحَدٍ مِنْ خَلْقِكَ، فَمِنْكَ وَحْدَكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ، فَلَكَ الْحَمْدُ وَلَكَ الشُّكْرُ**  
The Prophet ﷺ said, whoever says this supplication in the morning or evening has fulfilled the gratitude that is due upon him for that morning or evening. (Abu Dawud)
10. **فَسُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ حِينَ تُمْسُونَ وَحِينَ تُصْبِحُونَ. وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ فِي السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ وَعَشِيًّا وَحِينَ تُظْهِرُونَ، يُخْرِجُ الْحَيَّ مِنَ الْمَيِّتِ وَيُخْرِجُ الْمَيِّتَ مِنَ الْحَيِّ وَيُحْيِي الْأَرْضَ بَعْدَ مَوْتِهَا وَكَذَلِكَ تُخْرَجُونَ**  
By reciting this morning and evening the shortcomings in our dhikr are fulfilled. (Muslim)
11. **اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي بَدْنِي، اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي سَمْعِي، اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي بَصَرِي، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ**  
Seeking 'Afiya' in one's body, hearing and sight. Afiya is translated as well being in every way. Nabi ﷺ instructed us to ask for Afiya.
12. **رَبِّ اشْرَحْ لِي صَدْرِي (25) وَيَسِّرْ لِي أَمْرِي (26) وَاخْلُفْ عَقْدَةً مِّنْ لِّسَانِي (27) يَفْقَهُوا قَوْلِي (28)**  
Dua of Musa (AS) in the Quran. This dua has profound effects for students aiming to master sacred knowledge.
13. **اللَّهُمَّ أَرِنَا الْحَقَّ حَقًّا، وَأَرِزُقْنَا إِتْبَاعَهُ، وَأَرِنَا الْبَاطِلَ بَاطِلًا، وَأَرِزُقْنَا اجْتِنَابَهُ**  
O Allah! Show us the truth as True, and inspire us to follow it. Show us falsehood as Falsehood, and inspire us to abstain from it. Dua of Abu Bakr Al Siddiq (RA) and Umar ibn Al Khattab (RA)
14. **اللَّهُمَّ عَلَّمْنَا مَا يَنْفَعُنَا وَانْفَعْنَا بِمَا عَلَّمْتَنَا وَزِدْنَا عِلْمًا**  
O Allah! Benefit me with that which You have taught us and teach me that which will benefit us and increase us in knowledg. (Ibn Majah)
15. **اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ عِلْمٍ لَا يَنْفَعُ وَمِنْ قَلْبٍ لَا يَخْشَعُ وَمِنْ نَفْسٍ لَا تَشْبَعُ وَمِنْ عَيْنٍ لَا تَدْمَعُ وَمِنْ دَعْوَةٍ لَا يُسْتَجَابُ لَهَا**  
O Allah, I seek refuge with You from knowledge that is of no benefit, from a supplication that is not heard, from a heart that does not fear (You) and from a soul that is not satisfied. (Ibn Majah)
16. **اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَيَّ سَيِّدِنَا مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَى آلِ مُحَمَّدٍ وَبَارِكْ وَسَلِّمْ**  
Nabi ﷺ said, Whoever sends blessings upon me once, Allah will send blessings upon him tenfold, erase ten sins from him, and will raise him ten degrees in status (Nasā'ī)
