§ 18-1. Smoking prohibited.

Smoking is prohibited inside village facilities. This includes the Village Office/Garage Complex, Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Water Plant. All village facilities are designated as smoke free.

§ 18-2. Posting of signs.

"No smoking" signs or the international "No smoking" symbol (consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a diagonal red line through its cross-section) will be clearly, sufficiently and conspicuously posted at each building entrance. Such signs will be posted by the Village of Champlain.

§ 18-3. Smoking prohibited in municipal vehicles.

Smoking is also prohibited in all municipal vehicles used by village employees.

§ 18-4. Penalties for offenses.

Employees found smoking inside village facilities, vehicles or on the job will be considered in violation of this policy and will be disciplined in accordance with the provisions of the Village of Champlain Personnel Policy.

§ 18-5. Notification of rules.

Copies of these rules will be posted and distributed to all employees and to all new employees upon employment.

§ 18-6. Enforcement.

The Superintendent of Public Works will be designated as an agent to assist in the enforcement of this policy by notifying employees who are in violation.

§ 18-7. Future amendment.

This policy may be amended from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Champlain. All amendments shall be in conformance with New York State Law, and employees will be notified accordingly.
