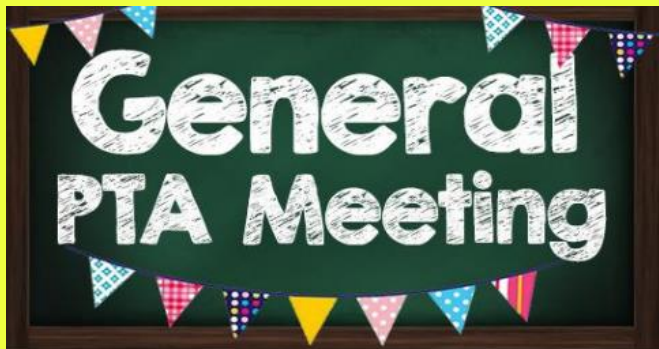

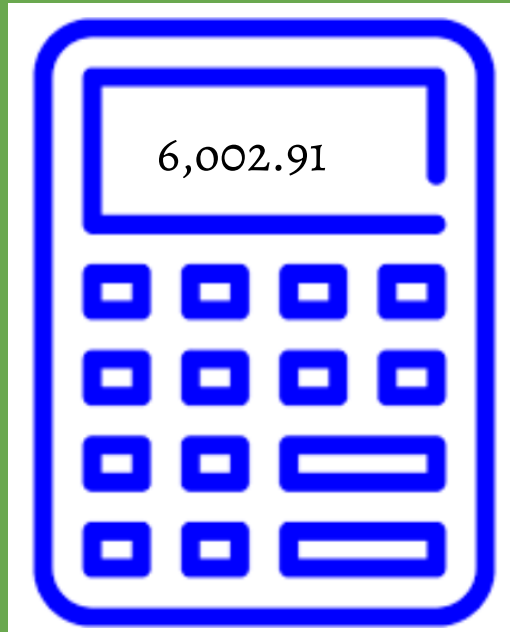

1. Policy for refunds all stores need have to post price

2. Businesses can't have cashless payment only

3. All businesses have to keep doors closed during summer due environmental concerns

4. They provide licenses a lot of NYS businesses like car dealerships, towing companies, horse carriages, etc

5. *Don't license cannabis business but alcohol and tobacco they are currently out investigating business illegally up and running.**

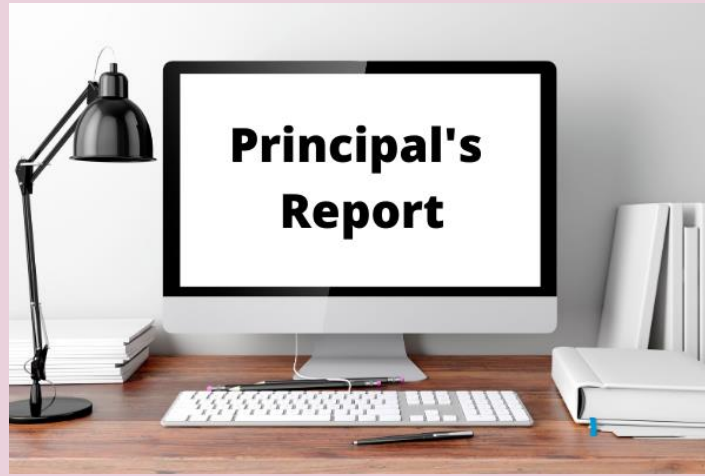
