Holland International School provides excellent Dutch and English primary education for children aged 18 months to 12 years. With over a century of educational experience in Singapore, Holland International School creates a rich learning environment that empowers students to bring out their best. The Dutch approach to education is a core element of the school's identity, fostering a culture of equality, collaboration, and independent thinking. Students learn in an investigative yet structured manner, taking control of their own learning process, enabling them to set their own goals and focus on areas of personal interest. Within the English Stream, the primary language of instruction is English, both for the English National Curriculum and the International Primary Curriculum (IPC). The Dutch Stream offers a mirrored learning experience, with the Dutch National Curriculum and IPC taught in Dutch.

The day-to-day management is in the hands of the management team, consisting of a director, who is supported by a management team. The team comprises approximately 45 teachers, a learning support coordinator, and support staff. They provide education to our students. The board, composed of five members, is responsible for the long-term financial continuity of the school and the quality of education.

Holland International School is a school of a neutral-special character and a legal entity (Limited) under Singaporean law. This means the school operates independently and is not affiliated with government agencies or philosophical institutions, nor is it organizationally



connected to other schools. All parents are members of Holland International School. We observe that parents are engaged in the school and their children's education.

The board of Holland International School (the Board) consists of representatives from the so-called "founding members" (Shell, ABN-AMRO, Heineken, and Philips) and potentially other designated representatives. The board is responsible for governing the school and is accountable for the policies pursued during the Annual General Meeting (AGM), which is held at least once a year.

The school has an international character. We not only welcome students from schools in the Netherlands and Belgium, but also from international schools elsewhere abroad and from residents of Singapore. This further deepens the view of our school as a significant component in today's international society and in ever-changing circumstances. Through quality education, we strive to prepare our students as effectively as possible for their roles in society. Our responsibility is to create a suitable offer for every child, emphasizing a holistic approach to education. In addition to focusing on cognitive development, our curriculum also places a strong emphasis on social, emotional, and creative development.
