ABOUT THE COURSE

For Councils who want to lead their local sustainability transition.

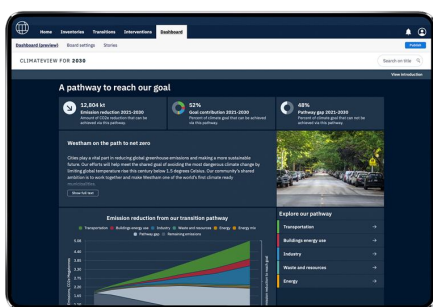
OFFICERS
