The Student Leadership Collective (SLC) is an apprenticeship journey rooted in and serving the local Church in Canada. The SLC creates space for grade 10 students to grow in their relationship with Jesus, discover their God-given purpose, and courageously share the good news of Jesus — starting in their schools, churches, and communities.

HOW DOES THE SLC WORK?

Trios: Two Grade 10 students and one mentor from their community apply and journey through the SLC together.

Pods: Trios are placed in regional groups to connect monthly and encourage one another.

Online Sessions: National online calls each month with teaching, prayer and equipping around leadership and sharing Jesus.

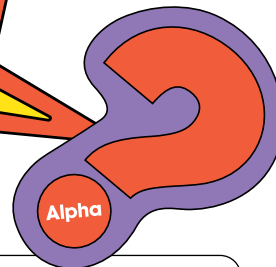
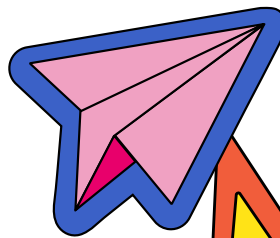
In-Person Gathering: A weekend to deepen faith, build courage, and be equipped in sharing the good news of Jesus.

WHO IS THE SLC FOR?

The SLC serves an ecosystem of people within the local church:

Students: This is your chance to grow in faith, discover purpose, and share Jesus at your school with courage.

Mentors: Walk alongside two Grade 10 students as a trusted guide and encourager.

Parents: The SLC comes alongside what you're already doing to disciple your child.

Church Leaders: The SLC is a tool in your hands to raise and release your Grade 10 leaders with spiritual depth, practical skills, and hearts to share Jesus.

WHAT'S THE COMMITMENT?

SLC students and mentors are expected to commit 3 hours a month, plus the in-person weekend.
