A key benefit for Orwell Park families is that our fees are comprehensive, covering far more than tuition.

They include daily meals, a broad range of activities, and a rich programme that supports every child's development. From Year 3 onwards, wraparound care is also included within fees, providing added flexibility for busy families at no extra cost via the ASPIRE programme until 7.45pm. Wraparound care for younger years is available at an additional charge.
