

As a member of TYC one of your benefits includes membership in the Gulf Yachting Association (GYA). The GYA was formed in 1901 as a non-profit organization consisting of thirty-four (34) members and five (5) affiliate yacht clubs from Houston, Texas to Sarasota, Florida along the Gulf of America.

Organized specifically to further the sport of yacht racing, marine safety and seamanship, the GYA is the oldest organization of yacht clubs in the United States. Originally formed as the Southern Gulf Coast Yachting Association in New Orleans in 1901 by the leadership of Southern, Mobile, Pascagoula, Biloxi, Bay Waveland, Bay St. Louis and Pass Christian Yacht Clubs. The founding organizations reorganized as the Gulf Yachting Association in 1918 and included Bay Waveland, Biloxi, Mobile, Pass Christian and the Southern Yacht Clubs. The GYA continued to grow in the succeeding years.

TYC PONTCHARTRAIN FOUNDATION

The Mission and Purpose of the foundation in part is as follows (for a full copy of the Articles of Incorporation, please ask one of the foundation board members):

ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE

3.1 Purpose and Mission Statement TYC Pontchartrain Foundation, Inc. is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

The specific mission/purpose of the TYC Pontchartrain Foundation is to positively impact lives by providing accessible educational and recreational opportunities on Lake Pontchartrain and benevolence for everyone, regardless of ages, sex, race, ethnicity, background, mental or physical abilities or ability to pay, thus providing access to a community asset that has been historically inaccessible to large segments of the population.

The TYC Pontchartrain Foundation shall enhance access to the Lake Pontchartrain area by utilizing the sport of sailing, and boating in general, as a platform to emphasize safety on the water, to develop independence and self confidence, improve communication, foster teamwork, as a platform for career development opportunities, and to acquire deep respect of the marine environment.

The TYC Pontchartrain Foundation will provide a regional educational program to develop water and boating activities on Lake Pontchartrain and provide improved access to boating activities.

The club has been busy these past couple of months despite being the “slow” season for boating. The Christmas Parade and parties as well as the New Year’s Eve gala kept things hopping and the trend continues. I do hear consensus that people are ready for the winter weather to abate and bring back more moderate temperatures. The winter solstice occurred on Sunday, December 21, 2025. It is actually an exact moment in time (not a full day) and was at 9:03AM CST. The solstice is when the Earth's North Pole reaches its maximum tilt away from the Sun, resulting in the shortest day and longest night of the year for us in the Northern Hemisphere. It marks “the first day of winter.” However, from that day onward, the daylight grows progressively longer each day. The gain is neither quick nor linear. It starts with a few seconds per day. Today we gained 1 minute and 24 seconds compared to yesterday. By now, the gain is noticeable – we have added about 27 minutes of sunlight a day since December 21st.

JANUARY RACING

We had four weekly WedNite learning sessions - *Racing Rules Refresher*, courtesy of David Dellenbaugh, <https://www.speedandsmarts.com/>. David’s site offers many other online courses including learning the rules, becoming a better crew and several aimed at improving your racing performance. He was accompanied by Dave Perry, a well-known author of the series *Understanding the Racing Rules of Sailing*. For the seminar Dave Perry handled most all the Q&A, which was archived as a google doc and the attendees have access to it. We enjoyed “burger, beers and lies” and had a good turnout for the series. Thanks to all who attended. Thank you to Michelle and Vince for the screen and projector set up.



Commodore Nick Colletti attended the GYA Annual Winter Meeting on January 10th at Pensacola Yacht Club. He connected with fellow GYA members and gained further insight into the workings of the GYA. As the TYC rep for GYA, I also serve on the Offshore Council. A notable change adopted last year for the GYA Offshore Challenge Cup is now that two clubs may combine to form a team. This year the Offshore Council is proposing a rules change to disallow “dinghy style” boats to keep the fleet more “apples to apples” in terms of design. Time will tell whether the GYA clubs overall will be receptive.

EZ RATINGS

The entire GYA has now migrated to the use of EZ ratings for handicap fleets. We will be using the EZ rating system going forward. This begins with the start of WedNite races on March 11th. To obtain or renew your EZ certificate for 2026, please go to: https://www.regattaman.com/certificate_page.php#. We plan to have sessions to discuss the details of the system application and what method of scoring makes sense for our fleet.

TYC JUNIOR SAILING / TYC PONTCHARTRAIN FOUNDATION

We added three additional Optimist dinghies to our fleet and now have a total of seven Optis available. They are all ready to go but one or two can use a little work prior to summer sail camp. The boats were obtained from the LJT Youth Sailing Program/Pelican Yacht Club in False River, LA as they have changed to a different training boat. We got a really good deal for the boats/rigs and two dollies with funding provided by the TYC Pontchartrain Foundation.



Junior Sail Camp weekly sessions this year are as follows:

Session One: June 1—June 12

Session Two: June 15—26

Session Three: July 6—17

Full details and online registration will be available through our website soon!
