

The next board meeting will be on Tuesday, May 12th at 6:00 PM.

The Mission and Purpose of the foundation in part is as follows (for a full copy of the Articles of Incorporation, please ask one of the foundation board members):

ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE

3.1 Purpose and Mission Statement TYC Pontchartrain Foundation, Inc. is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

The specific mission/purpose of the TYC Pontchartrain Foundation is to positively impact lives by providing accessible educational and recreational opportunities on Lake Pontchartrain and benevolence for everyone, regardless of ages, sex, race, ethnicity, background, mental or physical abilities or ability to pay, thus providing access to a community asset that has been historically inaccessible to large segments of the population.

The TYC Pontchartrain Foundation shall enhance access to the Lake Pontchartrain area by utilizing the sport of sailing, and boating in general, as a platform to emphasize safety on the water, to develop independence and self confidence, improve communication, foster teamwork, as a platform for career development opportunities, and to acquire deep respect of the marine environment.

The TYC Pontchartrain Foundation will provide a regional educational program to develop water and boating activities on Lake Pontchartrain and provide improved access to boating activities.



DID YOU KNOW we have a new big screen for big moments at TYC?

Following our last general membership meeting, the Board identified the need for an improved visual display system to better support meetings and events. A projector and screen were initially considered, and Mark Phillips was tasked with researching options that would meet the club's needs. As discussions continued, however, it became clear that a large smart television could provide the same functionality with far greater ease of use and far fewer installation challenges.

Once that decision was made, the next questions were obvious: where would it go, and how big could it be?

After additional discussion, careful measurements, and further research, the ideal location was selected inside the back wall window casing of the rear dining room near the exit. This spot offers a secure and discreet placement, keeps the television safely out of the way, preserves the club's aesthetics, and provides excellent visibility and accessibility for members.

With approvals in place, the club moved forward with the purchase and delivery of a stunning 98-inch, state-of-the-art smart television equipped with the latest features.

At that point, the real challenge began.

Our carpentry team was tasked with designing and building a secure support structure that would not compromise the existing window. The installation needed to look attractive from both inside and outside the club, avoid any damage to the wall, be removable if necessary, and fit seamlessly behind the existing curtains and header—while completely concealing the television when not in use. This was no small undertaking, but our team rose to the occasion with remarkable skill, precision, and creativity.

We extend our sincere thanks to our exceptionally talented members who dedicated countless hours to making this project a success: Mark Phillips, Bobby



Tassin, Sandy Stone, David Lander, and Nick for his encouragement and photography.

This new enhancement will serve the club in many ways, including membership meetings, board sessions, seminars, rentals, movie nights, sporting events, and more.




