### WHAT IS THE GYA CAPDEVIELLE SERIES?

The GYA, “Gulf Yachting Association,” consists of over 30 yacht clubs all along the gulf coast spanning from Texas to Florida. TYC is a GYA member yacht club and as members, we all have reciprocal rights to visit the other GYA clubs.

The **Capdevielle series** consists of 12 regattas hosted at various GYA yacht clubs throughout each year. The Capdevielle series is a GYA interclub competition and each club is eligible for one entry, racing in the Viper 640 sailboat.



Dedicated in 1941 to the memory of Auguste Capdevielle, this trophy is one of the oldest and most prestigious in the Gulf Yachting Association. Auguste Capdevielle served as Commodore-President of the GYA during the years 1936 – 1939. He was also Commodore of the Southern Yacht Club, and for many years served as SYC’s Race Committee Chairman.

Please look for and welcome members Adam White, Rob Prince, Dave Quinlan, and Fred Mannino to Tammany Yacht Club as they will be the primary team campaigning in the Capdevielle Series. The Capdevielle weekend regattas are a fantastic opportunity to visit other yacht clubs and support the TYC team.

**“Our lives are like rivers, gliding free to that unfathomed, boundless sea...”** Those words, written over 500 years ago by Spanish poet Jorge Manrique, have always stayed with me. Rivers bend, twist, and surprise us — and in October 2022, our family found ourselves swept into a bend we never saw coming.

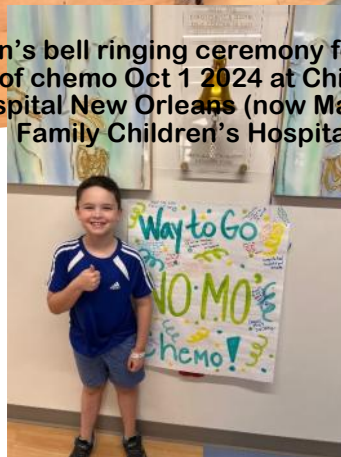
Shortly after starting kindergarten, our son Finn — a fearless, outdoors-loving kid who climbed everything in sight — was diagnosed with stage 3 embryonal rhabdomyosarcoma. One moment he was wrestling and running; weeks later he couldn’t stand. A large tumor was found in his abdomen, and our world shifted on its axis.



The next two years were a storm no parent is prepared for: six surgeries, 23 radiation treatments, over 80 weeks of intense chemotherapy. Finn lost his ability to walk, endured isolation, and missed the simple joys kids take for granted. But thanks to extraordinary doctors, nurses, and researchers, he survived.

Survival, however, is not the end of the story. Nerve damage left him unable to walk normally. Anxiety lingered. Confidence had to be rebuilt.

And rebuild he did.

Finn found his courage again on the mats — returning to Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu, wrestling, kickboxing, and youth MMA. In his first youth MMA fight, he locked in a triangle choke and won. The crowd saw a victory; we saw a miracle.

In 2026, we moved to Slidell, hoping for a fresh start near the water I love and new opportunities for my wife, a Physician Assistant. Our biggest worry was Finn — after everything he'd endured, would another change be too much?

We signed him up for TYC Sail Camp, hoping he'd meet kids and maybe discover something new. What happened was more than we could have hoped for.

Finn fell in love with sailing. Every day he came home excited to tell us what he'd learned — rigging, tacking, capsizing drills. At the camp regatta, he proudly took second place. Watching him on the water put wind back in *our* sails. Sailing teaches what schools can't: self-reliance, humility, bravery, resilience.

And TYC has been part of that strength.

From Bobby and Alan's dedication to young sailors, to Treasurer Bryon George opening his backyard so Finn can chase the Eden Isle's gar record, we have felt embraced by this community. TYC has given our son joy, confidence, and a place to grow.

Finn just underwent yet another surgery recently on his leg. He will be in a cast for 6 weeks, then a boot for another 6 weeks, and then several weeks of physical therapy. We know he'll return stronger. That's who he is.

Nothing stops Finn...not a cast on his leg or the need for crutches. He reeled in two gar recently (pictures above), which is no easy feat as anyone who has hooked and landed one of these gar fish knows.

Thank you, TYC, for helping Finn sail through recovery — and for giving our family a harbor in this new chapter of life.

*PS: I serve on the Patient Family Advisory Council for Manning Family Children's Hospital. I'd love to explore ways TYC could help bring sailing experiences to kids facing cancer and their families — even simple day sails could mean the world to them.*
