Delivering Core Programs: Our priority was refining and delivering on our foundational services designed specifically for kinship families. Through our Support, Advocacy and Case Management Programs, we touched the lives of **219 families**.

Prioritizing Partnerships: We are proud of the partnerships we have forged with community organizations to advocate for better support for kinship families. We partnered with Department of Family Services, Peggy's Attic, Family Resource Centers, The Center for Spiritual Living, Futons 4 Less, and Touch of Love to bring comprehensive support to our families.

Volunteer Driven: Over **50 volunteers** and **3 interns** solidly supported founder and director Alison Caliendo.

Broadly Supported: Foster Kinship won **third place** for most number of unique donors in Nevada's Big Give. **Over \$46K** was raised through individual donations, corporate grants and in-kind gifts. Total spend was \$33K.
