His work has received media coverage from outlets including Chicago Reader, VoyageLA, Las Vegas Weekly, ShockYa, and Film Threat, and he has appeared on Fox 5 Las Vegas discussing his contributions to the independent film community.

McFadden's directing style emphasizes emotional truth, restraint, and visual precision. Drawing from his background as an actor, he prioritizes trust and clarity on set, creating an environment where performances feel lived-in rather than manufactured. Whether working in drama, romantic thrillers, or animated storytelling, his films aim to linger beyond the final frame.

He is a member of SAG-AFTRA and the Producers Guild of America and continues to develop feature and series projects across the United States and internationally.
