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When You *Arrive*

Park in our designated lots and walk through the open gate.

Head directly to our Pick-Your-Own trailer, where a staff member will greet you.

At the trailer, you'll select your container size, pay, and be shown what areas we are picking at the time of your visit.

The container you're given to pick into is yours to take home!

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What to *look* for in a Strawberry:

 Choose berries that are fully red
from tip to stem

 Avoid berries with white or
green areas. Unlike some other
fruits, strawberries do not continue
to ripen after picking!

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Pick like a pro

 Gently pinch the stem above the berry

 Leave the green cap attached

 Place berries carefully in your container

 Avoid stacking too deeply to
prevent bruising

 Handle with care!

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After You Pick



Caution: Washing too early can shorten strawberry shelf life.



Keep berries somewhere dark & cool as soon as possible after picking



Store unwashed & keep berries dry until ready to eat

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Freezing *Strawberries*

 1 Rinse and dry thoroughly

 2 Remove stems

 3 Spread on a baking sheet and freeze

 4 Transfer to freezer bags
