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When You *Arrive*

Park in the lot in front of our Big Red Barn

Head directly to the ticketing windows at the Big Red Barn,
where a staff member will greet you.

You'll select your container size, pay, and be shown
what areas are being picked at the time of your visit.

The container you're given to pick into is
yours to take home!

Then, follow the signs to our Flower Field where
another staff member will provide you with cutting
shears and further instruction.

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Picking the *Perfect* Bouquet



Choose blooms that are just beginning to open as they'll continue blooming at home.



Look for strong, healthy stems and vibrant colors.



Mix in greenery and different flower shapes for a fuller bouquet.

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Keep Them *Fresh*

 Place flowers in water as soon as possible after picking.

 Trim stems about ½ inch at an angle before arranging.

 Change the water every 2–3 days and remove any leaves below the waterline.

 Display your bouquet in a cool spot away from direct sunlight and heat to enjoy it for days to come.
