School Meals – Moving to Arbor

After half term, we will be moving to Arbor for food choices. This means that you will need to select your child's meals in advance together. This change is designed to encourage conversations at home about healthy food choices and will also reduce the amount of time currently spent in school setting dinner options. At the moment, we are losing nearly an hour of learning each week due to this. Please also ensure your child brings water in their bottle rather than juice, to support healthy hydration throughout the day.
