Dear Parents,

We are at the beginning of the final year of your child's International Baccalaureate (IB) cycle and we would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the trust you have placed in us.

As you probably already know, the Extended Essay, the Theory of Knowledge, the CAS programme and the Internal Assessment Papers are specific to the IB diploma. In order to provide our students with the best possible support, we have, throughout this past year, informed them about the objectives of these assignments.

The Extended Essay is a large personal research paper (4,000 words) related to one of the IB subjects. It is carried out under the supervision of a teacher. The nature and amount of the internal assessment works are specific to each subject.

As a result, you may understand that the year 2025/2026 will be partly devoted to the finalisation of these Internal Assessment works. We would therefore like to avoid overloading our students with too much work due to the often poor management of the deadlines imposed by the IBO.

In order to make it easier for our students, we have established an internal calendar with all the deadlines that you will find attached. This schedule should allow you, dear parents, to keep track of your children's work. We thank you for your precious collaboration.

We also inform you that the official registration for the May 2026 exams, which will be invoiced at the beginning of the school year, has been set for Friday 17 October 2025.

The Class Teacher, the IBDP Coordinator and all the IB teachers are at your disposal for further information and wish you a pleasant summer.

International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme Y2

The respect of deadlines and the submission of reports are imperative conditions for a student's registration for the exams, since the Internal Assessment Papers are an integral part of the final grade obtained in the official session of the International Baccalaureate examinations. The deadlines given below are indicative and may be modified by teachers during the year.

Beginning of September 2025	<u>Extended Essay</u> : submission of the first version, Review of the work done during the holidays and evaluation by the teachers. <u>Geography</u> : submission of the Fieldwork version 2 <u>Visual Arts</u> : submission of the "Comparative Study" version 1 <u>Maths</u> : submission of the IA paper version 1 <u>Economics</u> : submission of the 2 nd IA work <u>Chemistry and Physics</u> : writing up of the first sections of the Personal Investigation
End of September 2025	<u>Exp. Sciences</u> : defining a theme for Project 4 <u>Biology</u> : submission of the first complete version of the Personal Investigation
Important Reminder	The validation of the 2nd session of the Extended Essay, as well as the submission of the work mentioned above and of the portfolio of CAS activities are imperative conditions for the student's registration for the May exams.
Beginning of October 2025	<u>CAS</u> : work progress monitoring
End of October 2025	<u>Exp. Sciences</u> : submission of the Project 4 report and public presentation <u>Visual Arts</u> : submission of the "Portfolio" version 1 <u>Chemistry and Physics</u> : submission of the Personal Investigation version 1
Beginning of December 2025	<u>Geography</u> : submission of the Fieldwork final version <u>History</u> : submission of the final IA paper <u>Biology</u> : submission of the final version of the Personal Investigation
Mid-December 2025	<u>Maths</u> : submission of the final IA paper <u>TOK</u> : submission of the Written Assignment
Beginning of January 2026	<u>Extended Essay</u> : submission of the final EE and 3 rd session RPPF <u>Languages A HL</u> : submission of the Written Assignment <u>Economics</u> : submission of the 3 rd IA work
End of January 2026	<u>Chemistry and Physics</u> : submission of the final version of the Personal Investigation

Before the February holidays	<u>Visual Arts</u> : Submission of the final “Portfolio”, “Comparative Study” and “Curatorial Rationale” <u>CAS</u> : submission of the final CAS portfolio
1 March 2026	All assignments are emailed to the coordinator for final submission to the IB.
March 2026	<u>Visual Arts</u> : oral exam (to be decided by the examiner). ENSR High School exams and mock exam.
From Tuesday 7 to Friday 17 April 2026	Easter holidays and revision courses (Experimental Sciences and Mathematics) . The detailed schedule and terms will be communicated later on.
From Monday 27 April to Wednesday 20 May 2026	Official IBDP examination session.

(The detailed schedule for each examination subject will be communicated at a later date.)

6 July 2026	Publication of the results on the Internet. Each candidate will receive by email a password in February/March to obtain his/her results personally on the website.
September 2026	Graduation ceremony. The date will be communicated in due course.
