PROJECT LOCATION:

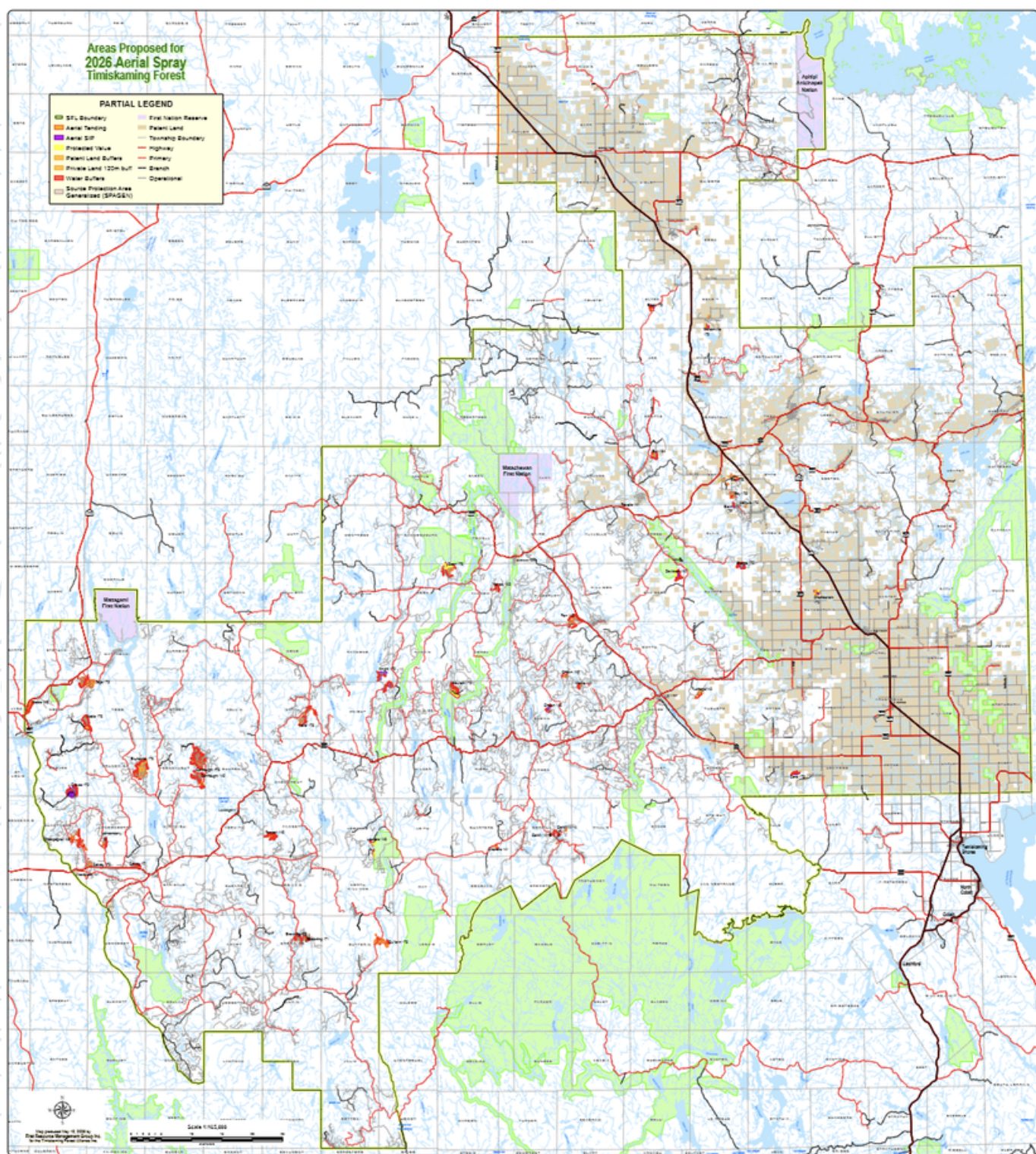
The map below provides information about the sites that could be sprayed.

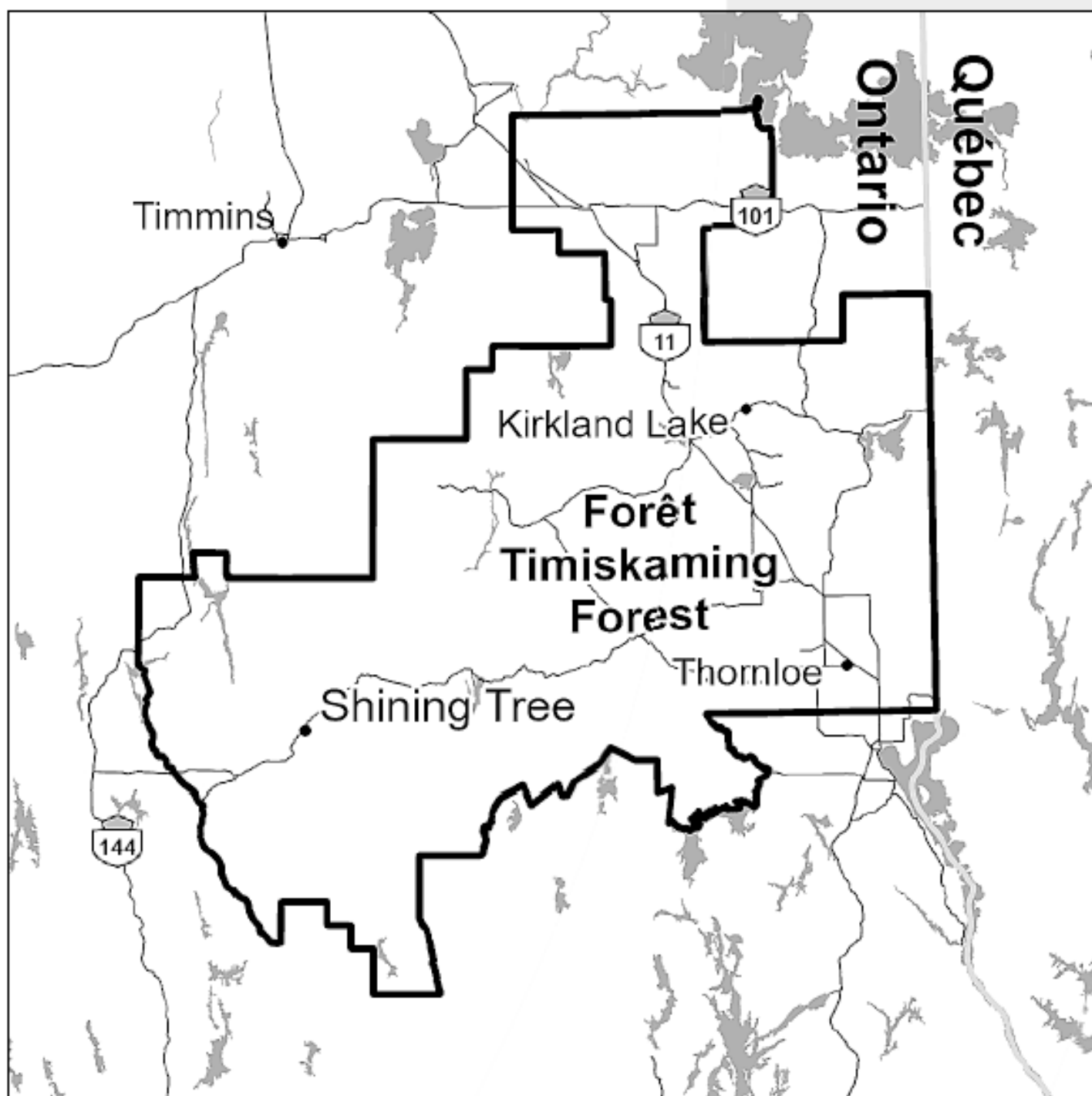

Inspection of Herbicide Project for Timiskaming Forest

The Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) invites you to inspect the planned herbicide project for the 2026 season. As part of ongoing efforts to regenerate and protect Ontario's forests, selected stands on the **Timiskaming Forest** (see map) will be sprayed with herbicide to control competing vegetation, starting on or about: **July 10, 2026**.
