PROJECT LOCATION:

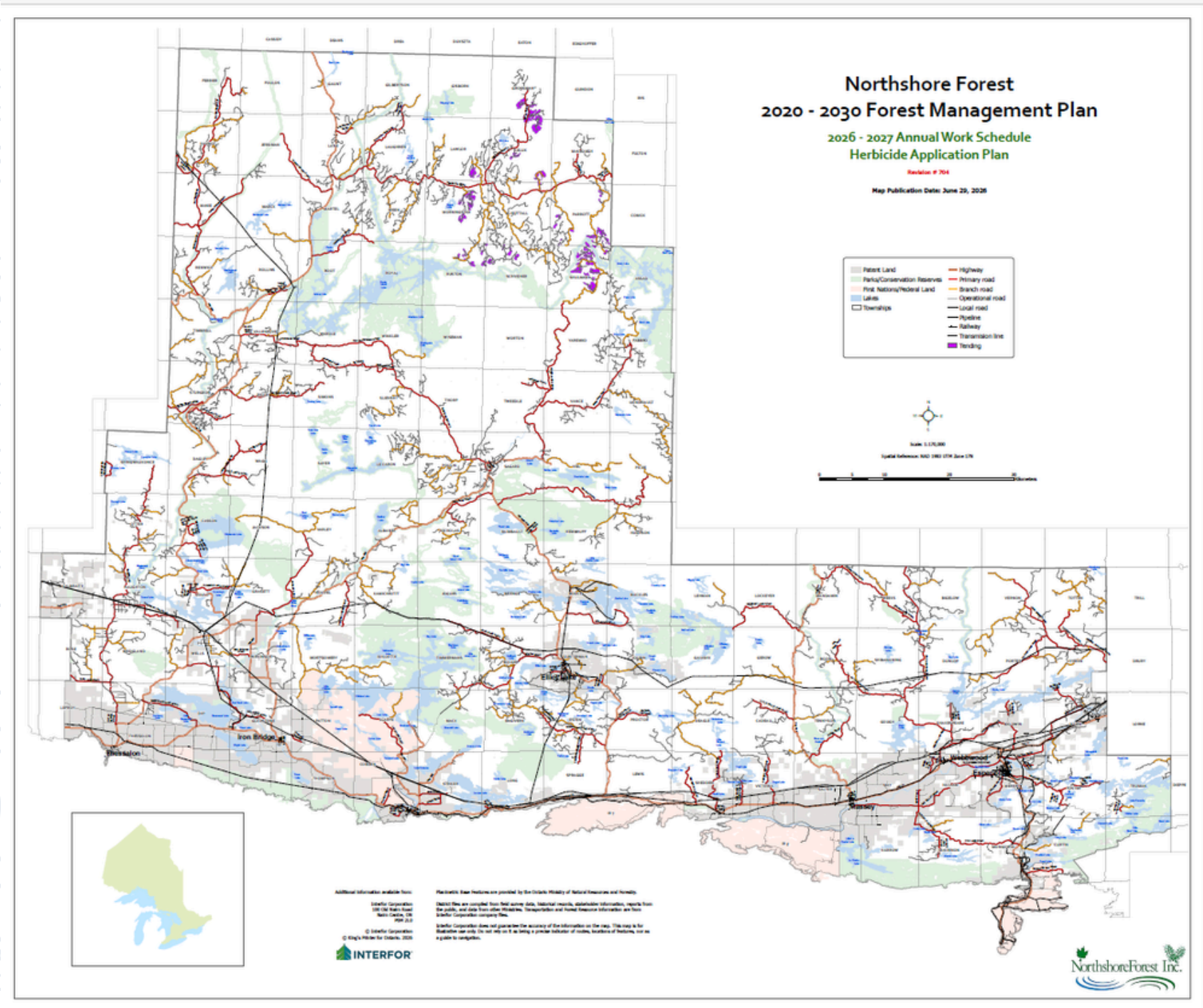
The map below provides information about the sites that could be sprayed.

Inspection of Herbicide Project for Northshore Forest

The Ontario **Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR)** invites you to inspect the planned herbicide project for the **2026** season. As part of ongoing efforts to regenerate and protect Ontario's forests, selected stands on the **Northshore Forest** (see map) will be sprayed with herbicide to control competing vegetation, starting on or about: **August 18, 2026**.
