The Central Institute of Family Medicine (CIFM) is a registered organization under the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP), established to advance family medicine and support the education and professional growth of family physicians. Headquartered in Lahore, CIFM operates through its district chapters across Pakistan, ensuring accessibility to its programs nationwide.

The institute's scope includes organizing training sessions for family physicians, providing Continuing Medical Education (CME) and Continuous Professional Development (CPD), conducting Train-the-Trainer courses, and offering preparatory programs for postgraduate family medicine examinations. Additionally, CIFM plays a pivotal role in teaching undergraduate students, establishing family physicians' clinics, and facilitating practice management.

It also inspects clinics and hospitals for accreditation as family medicine training centers and trains and recruits faculty for family medicine programs across Pakistan. Moreover, the institute offers consultancy to government and non-government medical teaching institutions on matters related to family medicine and provides capacity-building courses for postgraduate trainees in research, synopsis and dissertation writing, and publications.

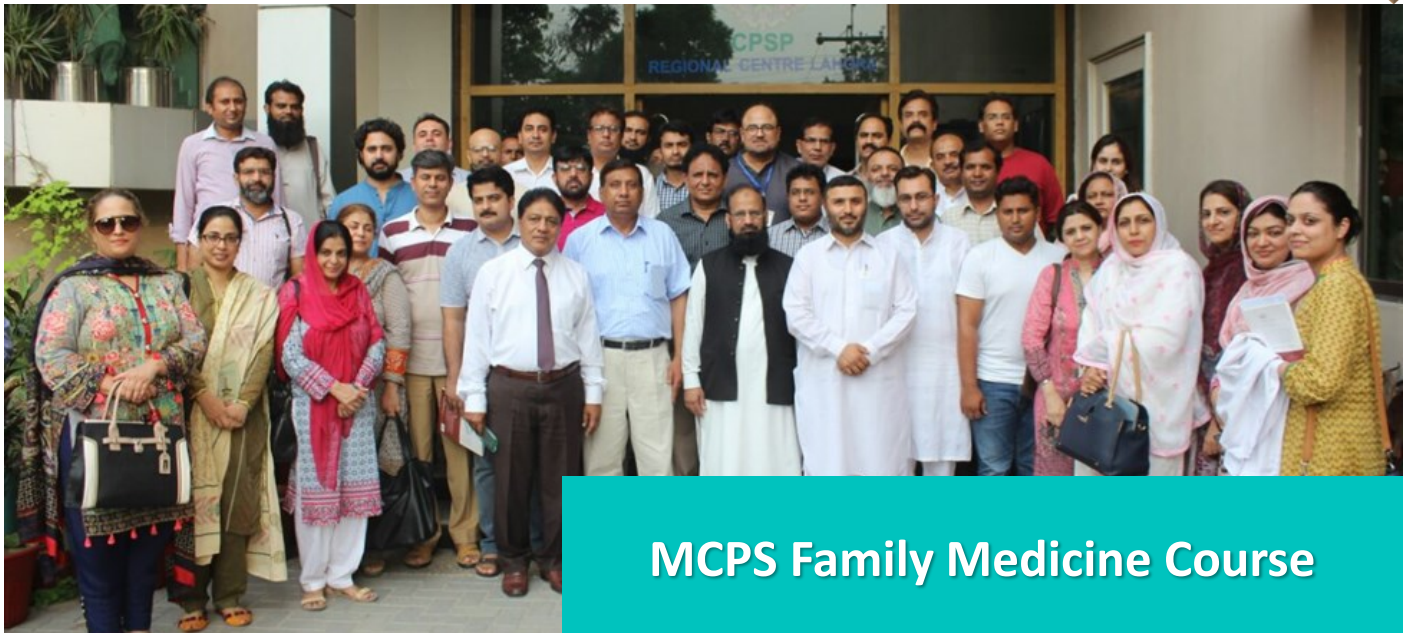

Certificate in Clinical Teaching and Assessment

This course is specially designed for family physicians who have passed MCPS or MRCP (INT) and want to become faculty of family medicine.

The purpose of the course is to impact the practical skills of teaching assessment of the faculty. It consists of workshops and assignments. It is one of the most practical medical education courses for ambulatory teaching.

Research and Publication Course

This course is specially designed to foster research mindset and inculcate basic research skills in post graduate trainees. It enables postgraduate trainees to prepare their own synopsis, thesis and dissertation under supervision of research facilitators and learn genuine research.

It is conducted practically hands-on.

The research teachers take the PG trainees all along the course of synopsis/thesis/dissertation starting from topic till final draft of submission taking full ownership of the trainee. This also share the load of their clinical supervisors and allows their clinical supervisors to focus on clinical education.



Online Diploma in Family Medicine

This course is designed for fresh MBBS graduates who want to start their independent practice. It provides post-graduate level training to fresh graduates so that they have the confidence and the competence required for independent clinical practice.

Family Medicine Residency Programs

These are full time structured residency programs based on the international curricula of Family Medicine residency programs of the United Kingdom, Australia and Canada. These residency programs consist of clinical rotations in different specialties, placement at community based family medicine clinics, hands-on workshops, online sessions, access to online educational repository, reflective learning activities, leadership activities, portfolio, workplace based assessments and annual examinations.

The structured residency programs are customized to the practice and learning needs of the trainees. There are three structured residency programs;

- 1) 4-year residency program leading to M.D. in Family Medicine
- 2) 2-year residency program leading to Masters in Family Medicine
- 3) 1-year residency program leading to Diploma in Family Medicine

At the completion of training, the participants will receive their portfolio and a training transcript in addition to the degree.

1-year Residency in Family Medicine

This is a one-year residency program for fresh medical graduates in accordance with the WHO EMRO resolution EM/RC63/R.2, October 2016 to achievement of targets of SGD 3 . All the basic clinical rotations and family medicine training will be completed in one year.

Any MBBS doctors after completing house job can apply for this residency program

The training will consist of highest level of training based on the modern principles of medical education. The passing out candidates will have a Diploma in Family Medicine, a complete transcript of training and a portfolio.

The final certificate will be provided by HEC recognized medical universities of Pakistan. In addition doctors with prior two year experience can also appear in MRCGP [INT] final examination based on this 1-year residency program.

2-year Residency in Family Medicine

The aim of this training is to prepare competent and safe family physicians who can provide high quality healthcare to individuals and families across all ages, genders and presenting with any disease, both at national and international level.

This is a full time structured residency program leading to Masters in Family Medicine. The training consists of clinical attachments, workplace based assessment, reflective learning, leadership activities, summative assessments and hands on workshops.

4-year Residency in Family Medicine

This is a four-year residency program. All the basic clinical rotations and family medicine training will be completed in first two years. The first two years mainly focus on core family medicine competencies.

The third and fourth years of training will have family medicine training throughout the year in addition to 6-month clinical rotations in specialties of interest of trainees. The third and fourth years mainly focuses on consolidation of family medicine training and excelling in the area of interest. The scheme of training is shown in the following table.

Core Curriculum weekly meeting

Once a week all the trainees gather along with the assigned faculty members face to face. The core curriculum sessions will consist of case-based discussions, presentations on important topics, clinical practice guidelines, physical examination skills, use of clinical equipment, communication skills, critical appraisal of research articles and practice management related topics.

The day assigned for core curriculum will be a protected time for the trainees and they will be relieved from their postings to attend core curriculum meetings.
