**The Community Service Worker will perform the following tasks:**

- Provide a safe and welcoming environment for food bank clients
- Build relationships with immigrants and low-income families throughout the week
- Create materials in English, Farsi, Arabic, and other languages
- Facilitate beginner English learning conversation classes for New Canadians
- Create a judgment-free space for English learners to practice listening and talking
- Teach about Canadian culture, such as holidays and traditions
- Assist in running evening events/services focused on reaching Next Gen
- Brainstorm and test out creative ways to engage and build relationships with young people
- Other duties as required

- Prepare an outdoor campsite for an outreach program for Indigenous youth
- Build relationships with outreach team and local partners
- Run errands to prepare for any service initiatives
