



House rules for the holiday home Chalet Laret

Welcome! We are pleased that you are our guest. To ensure that you and future guests feel comfortable, we ask you to follow a few simple rules. Please treat the house as if it were your own.

Air

Please ventilate briefly and vigorously every day (shock ventilation for 5-10 minutes), especially after cooking, showering and sleeping.

Avoid permanently tilted windows to prevent energy loss.

Cook

Please use the extractor hood when cooking.

Food residues, fats or oils do not belong in the drain.

After use, please clean the stove and work surfaces.

Fireplace

You are welcome to use the fireplace, however, only wood may be burned. Paper, cardboard and waste do not belong in the fireplace. In the basement, wood is available for use free of charge.

Caution: The chimney flap must be opened before use. Please close again after use.

House cleaning

For daily cleaning, you will find a vacuum cleaner next to the stairs in the basement. A broom, various cleaning rags and buckets are next to the washing machine. Cleaning agents can be found in the kitchen in the drawer next to the window.



When liquids have been spilled, wipe them immediately with a slightly damp household paper.

Washing / Drying

Washing machine and dryer may be used. Laundry detergent is available free of charge. To save electricity, washing should only be done with a full machine if possible.

To hang up the laundry, use the drying rack.

Snow & Outdoor Area

In winter, we ask you to clear and grit the access routes briefly if necessary. Shovel and gritting agent are in the garage.

Please cover or store garden furniture again after use. The garden furniture may not be taken into the house.

Skis/boots

You can deposit your skis in the garage, please do not take them indoors.

Leave wet, dirty shoes in the entrance.

To clean shoes from snow before entering the house, there is a small broom at the entrance.

Windows & Doors

Please close all windows and doors completely when leaving the house.

In strong winds or rain, make sure to close the windows in good time.



Dogs & Pets

Dogs are welcome. The rules set out in the additional provision must be followed.

Please no animals on sofa or beds.

Please always remove droppings in the garden or on paths.

Smoke

Smoking is not allowed in the house.

Please use the terrace or garden and dispose of cigarette residues in a clean manner and not in the garden.

Rest periods

Please respect the neighborhood and observe nightly quiet hours (10:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m.).

Waste & Recycling

Please separate waste into residual waste, paper, glass and plastic.

Only the blue waste bags are to be used for residual waste. These can be purchased at the checkout in any supermarket.

The blue waste bags can be disposed of at the collection point opposite Lareterstrasse 17 (road towards the train station). For details, see information on departure.



Departure

Please leave the house tidy and swept clean.

Please put used bath towels in the bathroom, the bed linen does not have to be removed, please leave it on the beds.

Leave dirty cleaning rags in the bucket next to the washing machine.

Empty the fridge, wash and store dishes, close windows and doors and deposit keys in the key compartment.

Close the chimney flap.

If the house is not left in accordance with these guidelines, there will be an additional charge to cover expenses.

Don't forget to log out of your TV streaming services. We do not accept any liability in the event that your accounts remain logged in.

Dispose of waste:

Garbage bags: deposit in the blue garbage bag at the collection point opposite Lareterstrasse 17 or at the bus terminus Davos Laret.

Waste paper/cardboard: bundled, (tied together with a string) deposited at the collection point opposite Lareterstrasse 17 or at the bus terminus Davos Laret.

Pet/glass/aluminum: deposit at the collection point at the Spar Davos car park, Dorfstrasse.
