Summary of Your Privacy Rights (Reference: 45 CFR § 164.520)

Your Rights - You have the right to:

- Get a copy of your paper or electronic protected health information
- Request amendments or corrections to your paper or electronic protected health information
- Request confidential communications of protected health information
- Request for limitations or restrictions on our uses and disclosures of your protected health information
- Get an accounting of disclosures those with whom we have shared your protected health information
- Receive a copy of this Notice upon enrollment or upon request
- Receive notification if affected by a breach of unsecured protected health information
- Delegate authority to someone to make choices about your protected health information
- File a written complaint without retaliation to the Privacy Officer at Valor Compounding Pharmacy or to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office at <https://www.hhs.gov/hipaa/filing-a-complaint/index.html> if you believe your privacy rights have been violated

Our Uses and Disclosures - We may use and share your information as we:

- Provide treatment or care for you with other health care providers and medical professionals
- Bill and obtain payment for your services from health plans, insurance companies and other entities
- Run our health care operations and safeguard records containing protected health information
- Tell you about your prescriptions, refills, treatment alternatives, and other health benefits and services
- Notify the appropriate government authorities if we believe a patient has been the victim of abuse, neglect, or domestic violence and for other situations related to public health and safety as required by law
- Reporting of adverse events as required by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA)
- Respond to organ and tissue donation requests organ requests
- Work with a coroner, medical examiner, or funeral director use
- Provide information to family, friends, and caregivers allocated by you
- Address workers' compensation, law enforcement, and other government requests authorized by law
- Respond to lawsuits and legal actions by a court or administrative order, subpoena, or other lawful process
- Report and notify affected parties and legal authorities of data breaches as required by law

Our Responsibilities

We are required to maintain the privacy of your health information. We will notify you promptly if a breach occurs that may have compromised the privacy or security of your information.

Your health information will not be used or disclosed without your written authorization, except as described in this notice. The following uses and disclosures will be made only with explicit authorization from you: (1) uses and disclosures of your health information for marketing purposes, including subsidized treatment communications; (2) disclosures that constitute a sale of your health information; and (3) other uses and disclosures not described in the notice. Except as noted above, you may revoke your authorization in writing at any time.

In all cases, if we have substance use disorder patient records about you, subject to 42 CFR Part 2, we cannot use or share information in those records in civil, criminal, administrative, or legislative investigations or proceedings against you without (1) your consent or (2) a court order and a subpoena.

By receiving this Notice, I acknowledge that a copy of the Notice of Privacy Practices is available for my review and a copy of this Notice is available upon request and that Valor Compounding Pharmacy reserves the right to change the terms of this Notice and that I will be notified of any amendments.
