2. DATA PROCESSED WHEN YOU VISIT OUR WEBSITE

You can visit our website without directly providing information about your identity.

When you access the website, our hosting provider may automatically process technical information necessary to deliver and secure the website, such as:

- ◆ IP address
- ◆ browser and device information
- date and time of access
- requested pages
- referring website

This processing is necessary to provide a secure and reliable website and is based on our legitimate interests under Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

3. COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

Our website uses cookies and comparable technologies, including local storage.

Strictly necessary technologies are required for the website to function correctly or to remember your privacy choices. These technologies may be used without consent where they are strictly necessary and permitted by applicable law.

Optional technologies are used for:

- ◆ **Analytics**, to understand how visitors use our website and improve it.
- **Marketing**, to measure advertising performance and, where applicable, support audience creation and campaign optimisation.

Optional analytics and marketing technologies are activated only after you have given the relevant consent. The legal basis for the related processing of personal data is your consent under Article 6(1)(a) GDPR.

We use FlowAppz Cookie Consent to manage and remember your cookie preferences. You can change or withdraw your consent at any time through the cookie settings available on our website.

4. SERVICES WE USE

Webflow

Webflow may process technical information required to host, deliver, and secure the website.

We use Webflow on the basis of our legitimate interest in providing a secure and reliable website under Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

Google Analytics 4

We use Google Analytics 4, provided by Google Ireland Limited, to understand how visitors use our website and improve its performance.

Google Analytics may process information such as:

- ◆ pages viewed
- ◆ website interactions
- approximate location
- browser and device information
- referral source

- session information

Google Analytics is activated only after you consent to Analytics technologies.

The legal basis for this processing is your consent under Article 6(1) (a) GDPR.

Meta Pixel

We use the Meta Pixel, provided by Meta Platforms Ireland Limited, to measure the effectiveness of advertising on platforms such as Facebook and Instagram and, where applicable, support advertising optimisation and audience creation.

The Meta Pixel may process information such as:

- ◆ pages visited
- website interactions
- browser and device information
- referral information
- identifiers associated with Meta technologies

The Meta Pixel is activated only after you consent to Marketing technologies.

The legal basis for this processing is your consent under Article 6(1) (a) GDPR.

5. CONTACTING US
