Children can:

3 To introduce 'man to man' coverage when defending

- Keep eyes on the hips of the person you are covering and not watch the QB

4 To look at 'zone marking' when defending

Children can:

- Understand what zone on the field they are covering
- Understand that they need to drop to the back of zone
- Need to be aware of any receivers entering and leaving their zone
- Understand they don't chase the receivers into another

Working Towards
