### High Risk Construction Work Activities



Select High Risk Construction Work Activity: \*

More than one High Risk Construction Work Activity can be selected.

Note:

- For Risk of a person falling more than 2 metres
  - In some jurisdictions this is 3 metres
- Work involving the use of explosives
  - Using explosive power tools is not considered 'work involving the use of explosives'
- For Work on or near pressurised gas pipes or mains
  - 'Near' means close enough that there is a risk of hitting or puncturing the mains, piping, electrical installation or service
- For Work on or near chemical, fuel or refrigerant lines
  - 'Near' means close enough that there is a risk of hitting or puncturing the mains, piping, electrical installation or service
- For Work on or near energised electrical installations or services:
  - 'Near' means close enough that there is a risk of hitting or puncturing the mains, conduit, electrical installation or service.
  - Electrical installations/services do not include appliances such as power leads and electrically powered tools

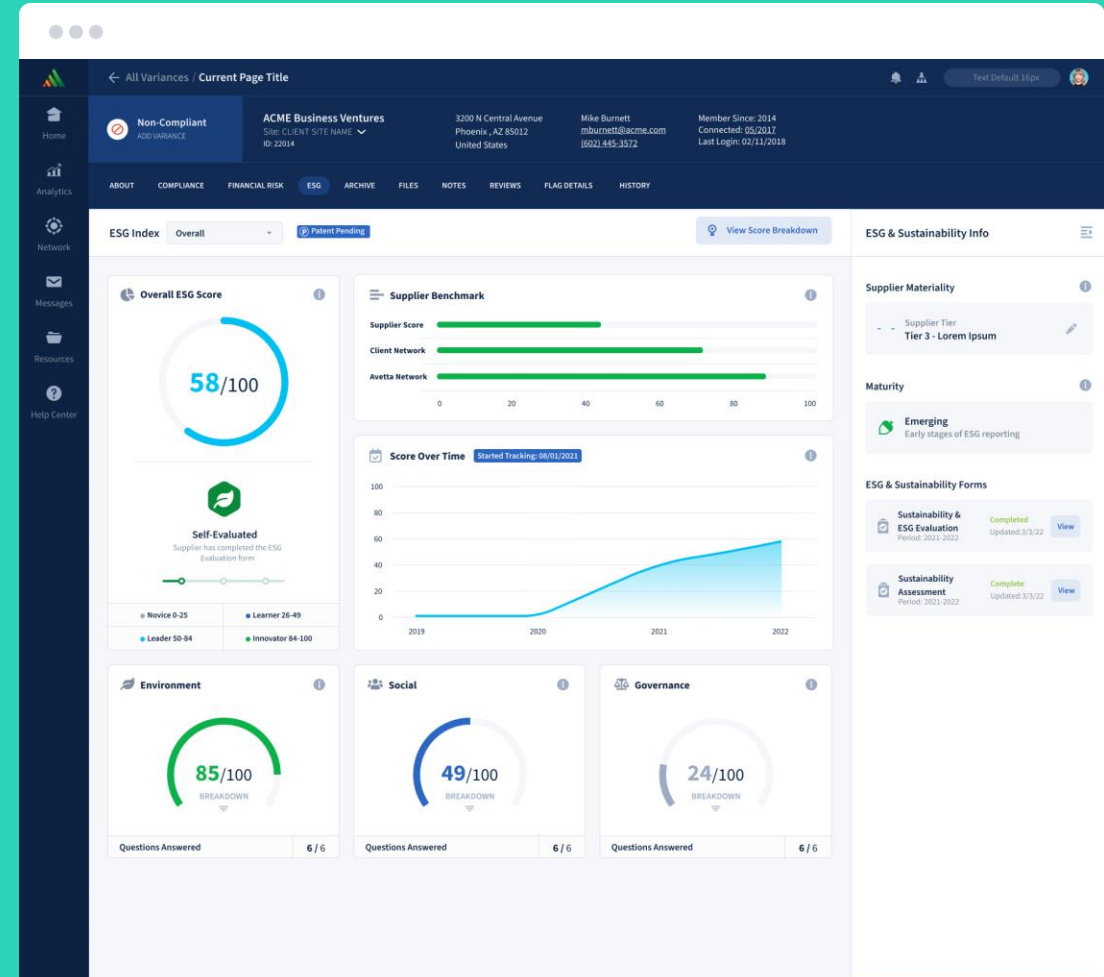
