# Award categories and entry questions

## Health & safety excellence award

Recognises organisations and individuals who have achieved measurable safety improvements by pairing leading and lagging indicators, embracing modern practices, and using Avetta solutions to reduce incidents and strengthen safety culture.

### How this award is judged
