

# MELBOURNE FLOOD MAPPING LITERACY AND ENGAGEMENT

A series of educational community workshops to capture local knowledge to inform updated flood mapping for neighbourhoods in the City of Melbourne.

## WHAT WE DID

- Designed and delivered a program of community workshops to inform updated flood mapping.
- Facilitated four workshops with City of Melbourne residents, including in-person and online sessions, to maximise participation.
- Developed interactive workshop formats combining expert presentations, mapping activities and facilitated discussion.
- Used large-format maps and place-based tools to capture local flooding experiences and locations.
- Supported participants to share lived experience of flooding impacts on streets, buildings and public spaces.
- Gathered community input on communication preferences and flood preparedness needs.
- Synthesised qualitative and spatial feedback into a clear summary of findings to inform flood modelling.
