

RIVERINE DESIGN GUIDELINES

Preparing urban design guidelines to shape high-quality development outcomes along the Murray River corridor.

WHAT WE DID

- Prepared a suite of riverine urban design guidelines to inform built form, siting, height, setbacks and landscape responses along the Murray River corridor.
- Analysed existing conditions, land use interfaces, environmental constraints and movement networks to identify key opportunities and sensitivities affecting river-edge development.
- Developed illustrated diagrams and spatial principles to clearly communicate preferred built form outcomes, public realm interfaces and landscape treatments.
- Worked collaboratively with DPE to translate strategic objectives into practical, design-led guidance suitable for use by planners, designers and developers.
- Provided urban design advice and peer review to ensure guidelines were clear, implementable and aligned with broader planning and environmental controls.
- Designed and desktop-published the final Riverine Design Guidelines document, combining technical clarity with accessible, visual communication.
