Developed a set of design guidelines for inclusive, accessible and welcoming community facilities across the City of Ballarat.

WHAT WE DID

- Reviewed existing Council strategies, policies and community infrastructure planning frameworks to establish a clear strategic foundation.
- Undertook high-level municipal demographic analysis to understand how age, ability, gender, culture, health and household change should inform facility design.
- Defined roles, functions and service objectives for different community facility types, including hubs, halls, libraries, kindergartens and maternal and child health facilities.
- Translated policy principles into practical design guidance, including minimum space requirements, functional layouts, inclusions and standards.
- Embedded universal design, access, inclusion and gender equity considerations throughout all design guidance.
- Developed clear decision-making frameworks, checklists and evaluation tools to support planning, design, delivery and ongoing operation.
- Produced an accessible set of Design Guidelines using diagrams, illustrations and clear language to support consistent application across Council and project partners


