# Summer Term 25-26

### RE

In RE, in our **Energy** topic, we will learn that Christians believe that the Spirit of God is active in each person and, in a special way, in the community of believers, which is the Church. It is the work of the Spirit to enable people to hear God's message and to live Jesus' way of service life

We will then move on to our '**Islam**' unit, learning more about a different world faith

Later in the term, we will discover Christians believe that, in Jesus Christ, the world has been reconciled to God. Through and in Christ, every human being is offered the power to reach out in forgiveness and peace, to receive and to offer reconciliation.

### Science

Science this term will begin with a focus on 'Forces and Magnets' developing our understanding that forces (pushes/pulls) act on objects, recognizing magnetic attraction/repulsion, and identifying magnetic materials.

### Computing

We will start the term by looking at Stop Motion Animation, and designing our own animations

We will then move onto Desktop Publishing, and using a range of apps and software to design and create.

### English

In English, we will be exploring and writing a range of 'instructions', looking at their features, and how instructions are useful to us in our daily lives..

Later in the term, we will look at narrative poetry, and have a go at performing well known poems, and writing our own .

### Maths

Maths this term will focus on furthering our understanding of 'time', and applying our knowledge to real life problems. We will then move on to look at how we interpret data and statistics

We will continue our regular practise of times tables.

### PE

We will be working on our cricket skills.

### History

Our focus this half term is on local history. We will be finding out about the history of 'The Railways' in the Lemington area, looking at 'the lines' and the importance of rail development in our area.

### DT

This half term we will be working with CHEFF, looking at healthy eating, and developing our cutting, chopping and cooking skills

### Geography

Later this term, we will be looking at the changing nature of 'Jobs' and economic activity focusing on identifying local, familiar jobs, understanding how land use changes over time, and exploring how these changes impact people's lives
