RE

In Religious Education, we will be focusing on Spread the Word: Pentecost, where we will learn how the disciples shared the Good News through the power of the Holy Spirit and understand the importance of courage.

We will also explore Rules for Reconciliation, exploring how saying sorry, forgiving others, and making amends can help to heal relationships and bring people back together in a positive way.

We will additionally look at Treasures, where we will explore God's creation and the idea that Christians see the world as filled with precious gifts.

PE

PE Day will be **MONDAY**

Focus: Strike and field.

English

In English, we will be exploring a range of different text types to develop our reading and writing skills. We will study poetry, focusing on language, rhythm, and how poets create imagery and meaning for the reader.

We will also write a recount, with a particular focus on explorers, learning how to structure events in chronological order and use descriptive language to bring experiences to life.

In addition, we will create an information booklet about St Lucia, where we will practise gathering and presenting facts clearly and engagingly, while learning how to organise information for a specific audience.

History

In History, we will be learning about nursing, with a specific focus on Florence Nightingale. We will explore her life and the important role she played in improving hospitals and healthcare.

We will investigate the conditions in hospitals before her work and how her actions helped to change nursing for the better.

Maths

In Maths, we will focus on the properties of shape, including identifying, describing, and comparing different 2D and 3D shapes. We will also explore their angles, symmetry, and other key features.

Alongside this, we will have opportunities to revisit a range of topics, helping to consolidate key skills, strengthen understanding, and build confidence in problem-solving.

Art & DT

In Art and DT, we will explore African art, focusing on patterns and styles to create our own designs. In DT Food Technology, we will learn basic cooking skills, healthy eating, and how to prepare simple dishes safely.

Computing

In Computing, we will be developing our skills in programming, learning how to create and test simple programs and understand how instructions are used to control outcomes.

We will also explore quizzes, where we will design and build interactive questions, and pictograms, where we will learn how to collect, present, and interpret data in a visual and engaging way.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about St Lucia, linking to our English work. We will explore the island's location, physical features, climate, and key landmarks.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about Animals, Including Humans, where we will explore how different animals, including humans, grow, survive, and stay healthy. We will also learn about the basic needs of animals and how their bodies work.

We will also study Living Things and Their Habitats, investigating different environments and the variety of plants and animals that live in them. We will explore how living things are adapted to their habitats and how they depend on each other for survival.
