

Minutes from ESSTS 6th meeting

Registration numbers up (34); many from Tammy's group.

Sponsors: 5k from Noema, Emalex: we are waiting for their response, Neupulse: no response, total 12 k so far.

MDS-tic study group:

- Systematic review about the complementary and integrative medicine: Tamara suggested ESSTS could participate but how would this participation come about?
- For the viewpoint: the goal of the work and the authors are already defined.
- For the future, we might discuss common projects together.
- Should we ask ESSTS members? let's discuss this during the conference.
- Let's plan a Doodle to discuss this matter (30 min).

Idea by Tammy: we could organize a webinar for teachers and schools about FTLBs (with a psychologist)

- Goal: to give information and guidance to schools in case of children with FTLBs.
- In exchange: donation to ESSTS?
- Cf paper in Frontiers.
