▶ The goal of this **1-2 page research report** is for you to select a topic of interest related to our course content, research that topic, and then **summarize and critically report your findings**. You may work solo or with a partner (each reviewing your own article about the same topic).

▶ Your article should be recent (within the last 5 years unless it is a seminal work) and from **peer reviewed journals** not popular media. Please select your topic from the approved topic list or submit one for approval. You will submit your **report and handout** to the **D2L Assignment folder and DB** so you can share your knowledge with your peers who will provide you with feedback. This is an authentic assignment to give you practical experience of thinking about current education research and creating a handout as a teacher.

- _____ Is informative and accurate (your “students” are your pre-service peers in this case)
- _____ Includes the reference citation for the article in APA style
- _____ Clear layout and easily readable (white space)
- _____ Uses appropriate graphics to create interest in the content
- _____ Grammatically correct
