

Claimant Assignment

This Assignment is made by Agreement on

If you sign this document you are transferring rights in your claim to your solicitors, Sentinel Legal Limited. This transfer will allow your solicitor to borrow monies which can be used to fund certain costs or disbursements in connection with your claim. It is important that you understand that any sums borrowed for your claim could be deducted from any damages you receive. If you are not clear about this or do not wish to allow this you must seek independent legal advice.

(**"Assignor"**); and

- (2) **SENTINEL LEGAL LIMITED** a limited liability company registered in England and Wales with company number 12826774 whose registered office is at Harley House, 29 Cambray Place, Cheltenham, England, GL50 1JN (**"Assignee"** which definition shall include its assignees and successors).

Whereas

- (A) The Assignor is the claimant(s), or intended claimant(s), in relation to a PCP claim regarding unfair relationships under the Consumer Credit Act (**"the Claim"**).
- (B) The Assignor has agreed to provide assignments and consents to the Assignee in respect of the Claim.
- (C) The Assignor has agreed to assign to the Assignee the right to the proceeds of the Claim that the Assignor is entitled to (**"the Claim Proceeds"**) and any insurance policy which is incepted to cover the Assignor's liability for disbursements and adverse costs in the event the Claim is unsuccessful (**"the Policy"**).

1 Assignment

- 1.1 In consideration of the payment of £1 (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), the Assignor with full title guarantee hereby assigns absolutely to the Assignee the Policy and all of its past, present and future rights, title, benefits and interests in the Claim Proceeds.
- 1.2 The Assignee undertakes to hold the Claim Proceeds on the following basis:
 - As security for the repayment of the funding provided to the Assignee in relation to the Claim (**"the Costs"**) (such funds may be deductible from the Claim Proceeds without reference to the Assignor); and
 - For any balance on trust on behalf of the Assignor until such time as the Costs have been paid by the Assignee to its lender at which time the balance of the Claim Proceeds shall be released from the terms of this



Assignment and shall be assigned back to the Assignor for £1, subject to the terms of the retainer in place between the Assignor and the Assignee.

- 1.3 The Assignee shall reassign the Policy and any rights, title, benefits and interest in the Claim Proceeds on the repayment of all the Costs at such time that no further Costs may arise and for the payment of £1.

2 Consent to Transfer

- 2.1 The Assignor hereby consents to:
- any transfer of the Claim, any entitlement of the Assignee to any Claim Proceeds or any other ancillary interest in either, to any group company or affiliate of the Assignee; and
 - the transfer of the Claim file to another firm of solicitors should Sentinel Legal Limited confirm that they are no longer able to handle the Claim.
- 2.2 Should the Claim file need to be transferred to any other firm of solicitors, the Assignee will provide details of such firm of solicitors to the Assignor.

3 Counterparts

This Assignment and Consent may be executed in any number of counterparts and all such counterparts taken together shall be deemed to constitute one and the same document.

4 Governing Law

This Assignment and Consent shall be construed and governed according to English law.

5 Third Party Rights

Each of Sentinel 1 SPV Limited and ORION CAPITAL FUNDING DAC shall be entitled to enforce any rights assigned to it by the Assignee and to arrange the transfer of the Claim file to another firm of solicitors under clause 2. No change to this Assignment may be made without the agreement of Sentinel 1 SPV Limited and ORION CAPITAL FUNDING DAC. Subject to the rights of Sentinel 1 SPV Limited and ORION CAPITAL FUNDING DAC only the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 shall not apply.
