Selling Clean Accounts

Why We Sell Clean Accounts

1. Pay

- a. We do **not** get paid on account that aren't clean
- b. On **top** of that, our operating partners sometimes cancel whole **bunches** (5+) of orders if even one of them is found to be dirty because they want to be careful! So selling bad accounts doesn't just hurt **your** accounts, but everyone else's.

2. Ethics

- a. We make a ton of money doing this job. You can get rich doing some shady stuff or you can get rich by becoming a great salesman, manager, and leader. Which do **you** prefer?

3. Time

- a. It takes time to sign up for a bad account and that time can be spent on an account you'll **actually get paid for**.

4. Consequences

- a. If you want to work with us, you **have** to sell clean accounts or you will be fired.

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What is *NOT* a Clean Account

1. An account with *your* phone number or email
2. An account with a gift card, cash app card, or your credit/debit card
3. An account where the address is *not* correct
4. An account where they don't understand they're being signed up

Our operating partners have systems in place to catch ***all*** of these things.

How to Sell Clean Accounts

1. **Get a valid credit or debit card that's in *their* name**
2. **Use *their* phone number and email**
3. **Use a valid address**
4. **Make sure they understand they're being signed up**
 - a. Fiber is such a no-brainer. One of the biggest things that holds people back is feeling like it's too good to be true. So, being upfront and honest helps you sell way more.

Selling clean accounts isn't complicated. Follow the steps above, be honest with your customers, and you'll never have a problem.
