2026 NYC School Survey

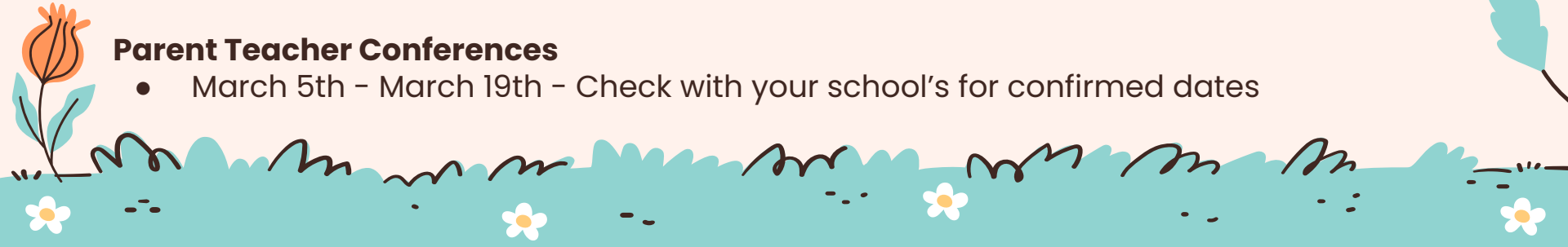




