DURAFLEX DF TO MEDALLION CONVERSION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the gray hopper plastic lid.
2. Remove the lighted merchandiser by lifting up to disengage the mounting “hooks” from the slots in the cabinet and rotating forward to clear the hopper top flange.
3. Remove the light bulb from the white reflector panel.
4. Remove the side and rear adhesive-backed decals. Clean the cabinet side and rear panels of any residue from the adhesive/decals material.
5. Install the stainless steel upper front panel with medallion by inserting the panel mounting “hooks” into the cabinet flange slots. Push down on the upper front panel to fully engage the mounting hooks. The sides of the upper front panel should be flush with the front cabinet flange; the bottom of the medallion panel should be flush with top of the beverage valve panel. If either or both of these two installation requirements are not done the medallion panel is not properly installed. Repeat the install and check for proper engagement of the medallion panel to the cabinet.
6. Replace the hopper lid.
7. Connect electrical power to the dispenser. Check for proper operation of the unit.
