INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

Disconnect power to the unit before servicing. Follow all lock out/tag out procedures established by the user. Verify all power is off to the unit before performing any work.

Failure to comply could result in serious injury, death or damage to the equipment.

1. Empty the ice completely from the hopper.
2. Disconnect electrical power to the dispenser.
3. Dry all of the water from the hopper.
4. Clean surfaces of crescent and hopper on the left side of the ice chute (when looking inside hopper with motor shaft hole below ice chute) with isopropyl alcohol or an approved ABS primer, (see Figure 1 and Figure 2).

5. Apply a bead of bonding glue to crescent, as shown in Figure 3 and Figure 4.

6. Place crescent, glue side down, on the hopper around the ice chute where primer was applied, (see Figure 5).

7. Hold in place for approximately 30 seconds, (see Figure 6).

8. Wipe up any excess glue inside the ice chute, (see Figure 7).

9. Apply a bead of bonding glue along the edge between the crescent and hopper. Make sure that this bead is neat and any gaps are filled in with more glue, (see Figure 8 and Figure 9).

10. (See Figure 10) for the finished installation.
IMPORTANT: Bonding glue must be able to 'cure' for a minimum of 24 hours before filling hopper with ice. Failure to do so may cause damage to crescent installation and undesirable ice dispensing results.

11. Check to see if hopper is clean. If not, follow Cleaning Instructions in the Dispenser's Owners Manual to clean the hopper.
12. Reconnect electrical power to unit.
13. Refill the hopper with ice.
