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1. Remove the lower front panel (2 screws) and discard.
2. Remove the (2) drip tray mounting pins, located at the lower left and right hand corners of the unit base, by lifting up on the pins to disengage the drip tray assembly from the base.
3. Pull the drip tray assembly forward from the Unit base to provide access. Remove the hose clamp on the Unit drain line located at the rear of the drip tray. Remove the drip tray assembly, cup rest, drain line and discard.
4. For -BC (units with coldplates) remove the existing L-shaped (2) drain tube from the cold plate. Replace these drain tubes with new drain assembly (item 2) on both cold plate tubes (item 3) provided around each cold plate drain. Be sure new drain lines are routed to appropriate drains underneath or behind Unit.
5. Assemble the new lower splash panel (item 1) to the unit with the (2) no. 8-32 1/2 long screws (item 4) provided with the kit.
6. The unit is now ready for operation.
