For Ice Diverter IDC/NGF/CF/FF Dispenser Kit P/N 629097086

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

All of the attachment screws and plates must be installed as directed in this manual.

Failure to comply could result in serious injury, death or damage to the equipment.

1. Remove upper front panel/merchandiser and the dispensing button panel from the dispenser.
2. Remove ice chute and ice gate and tape up the restrictor plate.



3. Install the diverter.

NOTE: Orient the diverter so that the U goes down and the flange faces into the hopper, as shown in Step 4.



4. Replace the ice chute, ice gate and remove the tape securing the restrictor plate. Note that the ice gate and restrictor plate should be located in front of the diverter.



5. Reinstall the dispensing button panel and the upper front panel/merchandiser.
6. Reconnect power to the unit. The unit should now be ready to dispense ice for customer use.
