## SPIRE 4.1 DRIPTRAY SAG KIT

### SAFETY OVERVIEW

### Types of Alerts:

## TOOL REQUIRED

- #2 Phillips Screwdriver.

## INSTALLATION STEPS

Review all installation steps first, before performing installation

1. Open door and remove Ice slide enclave, driptray & drain line / Clamp.

2. Loosen driptray base side screws (one each side) – do not remove.

3. Remove and save the two front driptray base screws. There are one screw on each side.

4. Slide bracket between inside of wrapper and base and hook onto the screws on – tighten side screws.

5. Slide bracket between inside of wrapper and base in front – reinstall the 2 screws from Step 3.

6. Re-install drip tray, drain line and clamp and then Ice slide. Make sure all are properly seated with no open seams between each.




Figure 9. Make sure enclave tabs are clipped in one each side.




Figure 10. Make sure front enclave tab is clipped in.
